## **Program Overview**

The 2014 AACD Perioperative Leadership Summit is designed for participants to gain a greater understanding of the future direction of perioperative management with a focus on perioperative quality management and data analysis. There will be significant discussion of the needs and challenges faced by Perioperative leaders related to resources, finances and care providers. This year's program focuses on the synergies and differences between academic and non-academic practices in an effort to identify best practices. The program will explore the expanding role of quality and information management systems and their impact from the perspective of nurses, administrators and anesthesiologists. ## **Program Goal**

The goal of this program is to provide a network for Perioperative administration colleagues to explore the roles and challenges of the operating room (OR) in a non-academic or director role, and to develop practical strategies and skills for effectively managing the challenges encountered in the work environment.

## **Program Objectives**

At the end of the Summit, participants will be able to:

- Analyze quality management programs in academic and non-academic practices.
- Discuss the impact of disruptive personnel on managing the perioperative environment.
- Describe the components of an Ongoing Professional Practice Evaluation (OPPE) program.
- Discuss ways of using perioperative data sets to develop predictive models.
- Examine issues and concerns specific to community and critical access hospitals.
- Create a network of colleagues who are involved in perioperative administration.
- Assess the impact of quality and data management on ambulatory surgical centers.
- Promote a culture of team building in the operating room.
- Initiate or expand a quality improvement program in the operating room.
- Identify ways to maintain efficiency in the OR and personnel accountability.

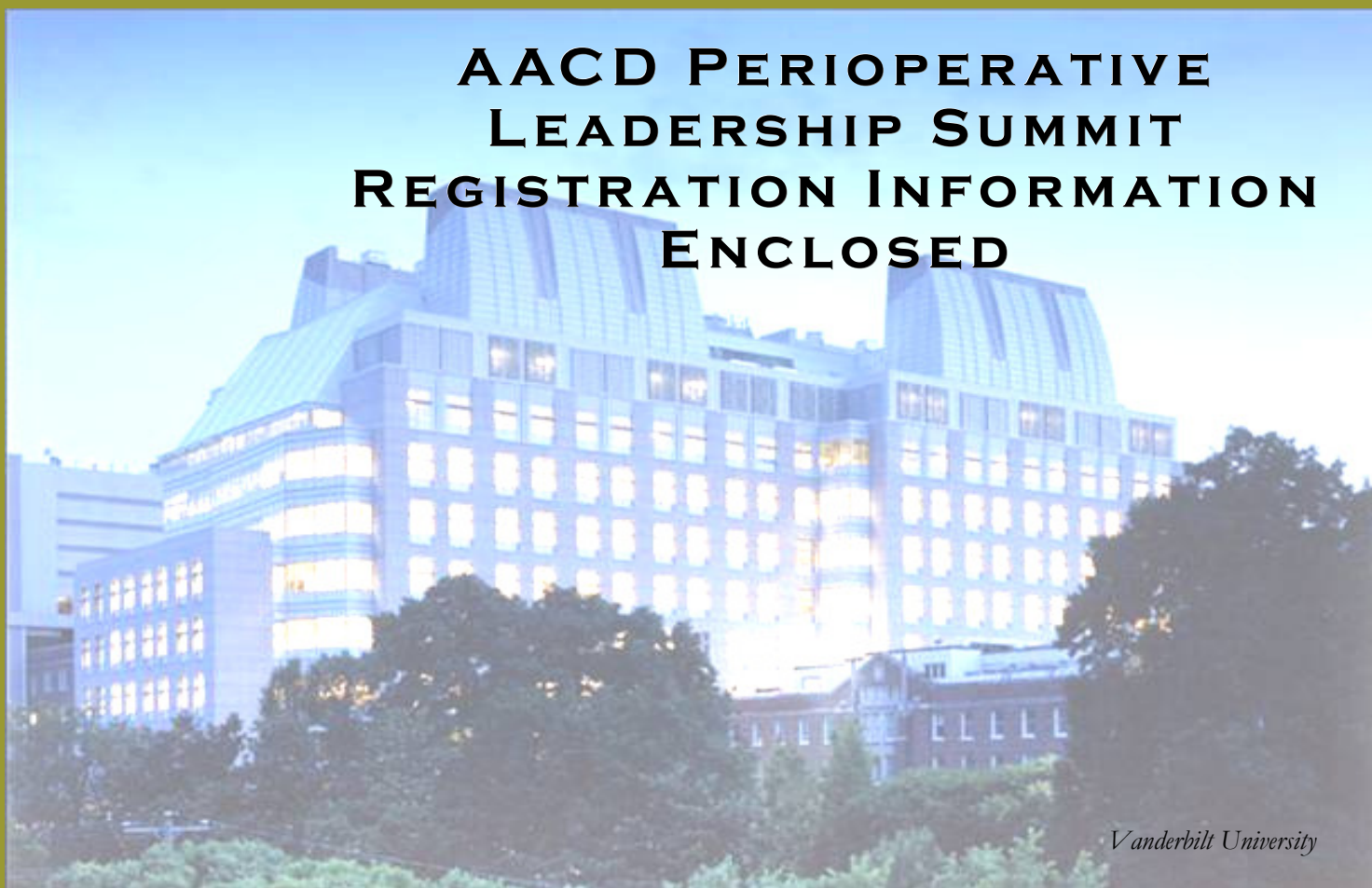
