Annual New Mexico HIV Conference

This annual conference is the only HIV update conference in New Mexico. Local, regional and national experts in HIV will cover clinical and socioeconomic topics in this one-day training. The conference is an opportunity for providers to gain access to relevant information and to network with statewide and national experts in HIV care.

Conference Objectives

At the conclusion of this conference, the participant should be able to:

1. Assess changing trends in the epidemiology of HIV in NM and their impact on clinical practice.
2. Identify new treatment strategies for HIV infection.
3. Recognize the prevalence and treatment strategies for comorbidities in those with HIV, including substance use, STIs, Hepatitis C, and endocrinopathies.
4. Identify strategies for improved patient engagement in care, including assessing health literacy and utilizing community health workers.

Transgender Health Workshop for Clinicians

UCSF Center of Excellence for Transgender Care Medical Advisory Board Member, Jennifer Hastings, MD, will present a four-hour workshop that will educate clinicians to provide evidence based, culturally sensitive medical care to transgender patients. Topics to be covered include hormone therapy, informed consent, risk reduction, routine screening, and fertility.

Workshop Objectives:

1. Describe the use of hormone therapy and informed consent.
2. Identify routine screening needs in the transgender population.
