8:15-9:15-Introduction to Ultrasound –Ultrasound physics, basic principles (4 variables – gain, frequency, depth, focal zones) Clinical anatomy and Characteristics of Tissue, (recognizing bone, ligaments, muscle, bursa, vessels, tendon, nerves, Hyaline cartilage and Fibro cartilage) Needle positioning (long & short axis)

9:15-10:15- Nuts and Bolts of Image Optimization and Injections – Knobology, Transducers types, frequency and attenuation, linear vs. curved appearance, modes, and planes. Doppler ultrasound and sterility procedures. principals of ultrasound guided injections to include needle tip identification, needle alignment, tracking needle, how to improve visibility of needle and Enhanced visualization and echogenic needles.

Ultrasound guided peripheral nerve blocks, carpal tunnel and the median nerve, Ulnar Neuropathy, Radial Nerve, Peroneal Nerve, Lateral Femoral Cutaneous Nerve, Intercostal Nerve Block, Suprascapular Nerve Block, Occipital Nerve.

Areas of focus include the shoulder (biceps tendon sheath, subacromial injection, acromioclavicular joint, glenohumeral joint, supraspinatus tendon and infraspinatus tendon) Knee (Osteoarthritis, Baker Cyst, Pes Anserine Bursitis, Patellar tendonitis), Hip (Ultrasound hip joint anatomy, hip injections long axis, greater trochanter probe placement and bursa injection and trochanteric bursa injections.
