Purpose and Objectives

Purpose

There are several risk factors and prognostic factors associated with periodontal disease. Attendees will learn how genetics, inheritance and epi-genetics play a role in this process and gain a better understanding of the link between systemic and oral health and how to prevent oral disease through management of inflammation and chronic diseases. In addition, the role of co-morbidities and how treatment options can be affected shall be discovered.

Objective

At the end of this course, all attendees should:

- Recognize how smoking, diabetes, estrogen deficiency, and xerostomia influence inflammation and periodontal bone loss during periodontal maintenance.
- Use knowledge about these common risk factors to modify periodontal maintenance content and frequency.
- Understand the genetics of inflammation and how that relates to periodontal disease, cardiovascular disease and osteoporosis.

Dr. Kornman is currently the editor-in-chief of the *Journal of Periodontology* and co-editor of *Clinical Advances in Periodontics*. He was previously professor and chairman of the Department of Periodontics and professor of microbiology at the University of Texas Health Science Center at San Antonio; currently retains an academic appointment at Harvard and is on the Board of Visitors of Duke University's Graduate School. He holds twenty U.S. patents; has co-authored three textbooks and has published more than 125 peer-reviewed manuscripts, including papers in *Science*, the *New England Journal of Medicine* and *Human Genetics*.

Dr. Kornman is actively involved in the clinical application of new knowledge in multiple common diseases of aging.
