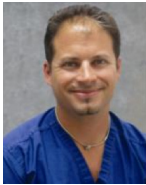

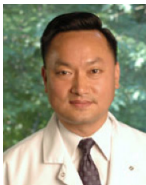
Dr. David DiGiallorenzo, DDS
