Abstract Submission Guidelines:

An abstract should be submitted under at least one of the above meeting session themes, and must include the following sections (please use Arial 11 point font, single spaced throughout):

- **Title:** of the paper in **bold** font
- **Authors:** First Name, middle initial(s) [if applicable], and Surname should be indicated for all authors. Presenting author should be underlined.
- **Affiliations:** Each author should be listed with their work affiliation(s), including the city, state/province, country, and postal code.
- **Key words:** Indicate up to 10 key words to allow for categorization of the paper to a meeting session theme (note: key words do not need to be meeting session theme titles).
- **Text:** The text of the abstract should be between 300 and 1000 words and include the following sub-headings:
 - **Introduction**
 - **Objectives**
 - **Methods**
 - **Results**
 - **Conclusions**
- **Abstract Type:** Please indicate **Podium** or **Poster** (note that some podium requests may be accepted as posters only, depending on the total number of papers submitted)

Getting to Foxwoods Resort

It is recommended that you fly into Providence Rhode Island at T.F. GREEN AIRPORT. Below is a list of airport transportation options:

1. Shuttle Service: Harry's Taxi offers a shuttle to Foxwood three times a day: 11:00 am, 6:00 pm or 10:00 pm at \$25 per person. In order to arrange your shuttle service, please call (860) 442-4054 to speak to a representative.
2. Taxi Service: you can pick up a taxi at the airport for a rate of approximately \$130. For more information call (401) 737-2868 or at www.airporttaxiri.com.
3. Sedan Service: you can arrange for a sedan which fits 4 people. Approximate rate from T.F. Green Airport is \$169 (inclusive of tax and gratuity). Call (401) 270-9997 to arrange your transfer.

If you fly into Hartford's Bradley Airport, below is some transfer information:

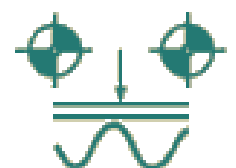
