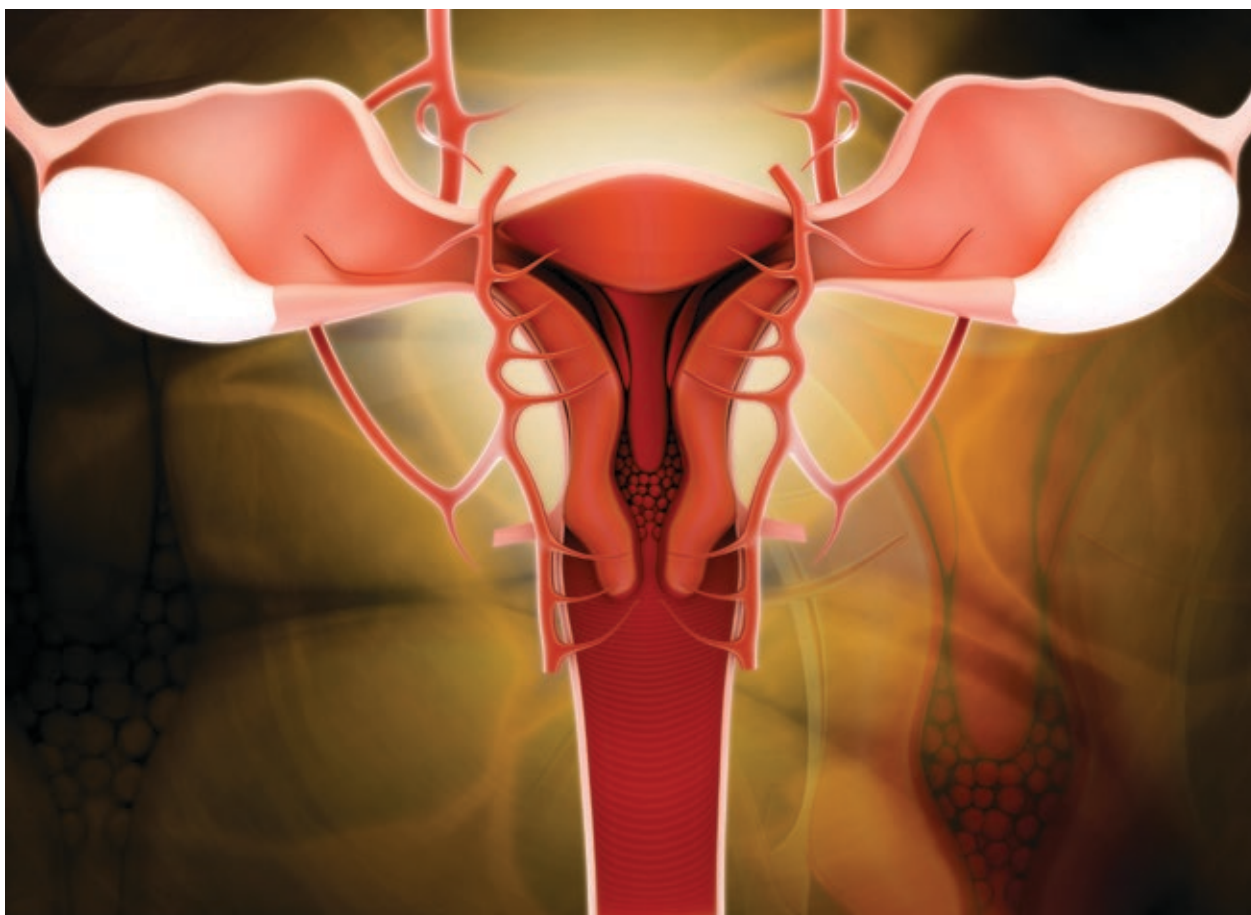

Dear Colleagues,

We would like to invite you to our endometrial cancer study day.

Over the years endometrial cancer surgery has evolved from standard abdominal hysterectomy to minimally invasive surgery. New developments are emerging from a different pathology insight to the introduction of the robot. Controversies still exist about the role of lymphadenectomy and conservative treatment in young women. Furthermore, it is becoming increasingly apparent that in some women endometrial cancer is just a side effect of a larger metabolic disorder involving diabetes, obesity and hypertension.

The aim of this day is to explore evidence on current ideas in treatment of primary and recurrent disease.

The day will be suitable for all those involved directly or indirectly in endometrial cancer management; gynaecological cancer surgeons, general gynaecologists, medical and clinical oncologists, cancer nurse specialists and other health workers caring for patients with gynaecological cancers.
