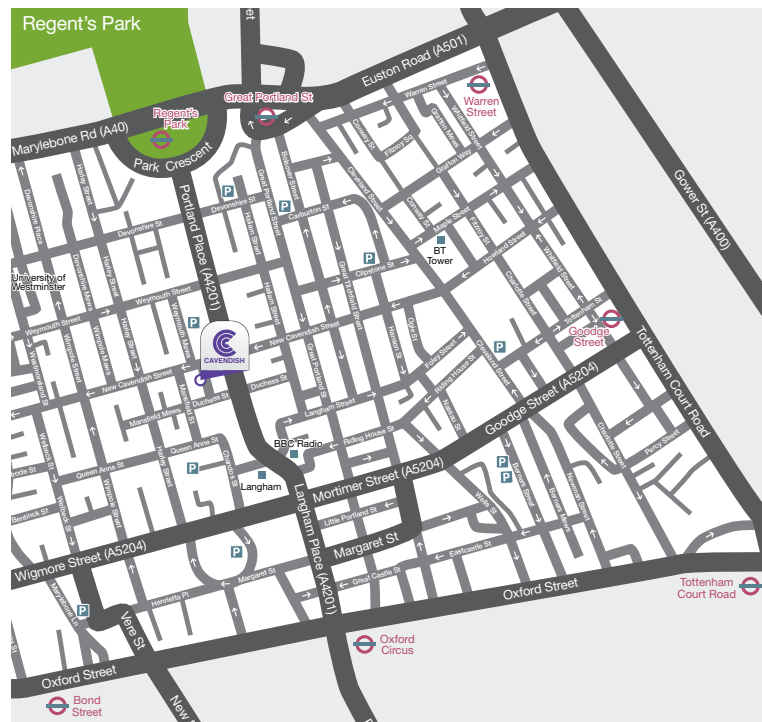

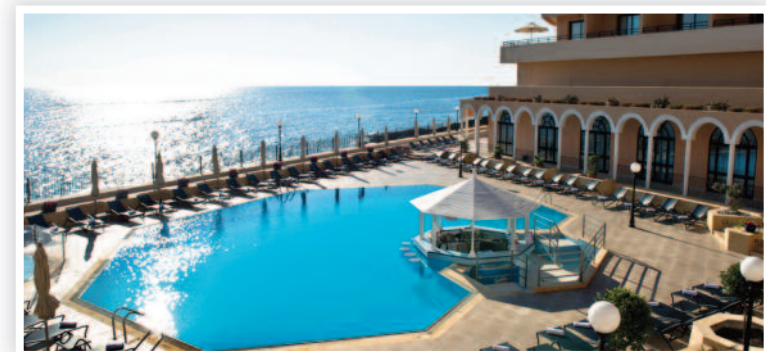
CANCELLATION OF BOOKING

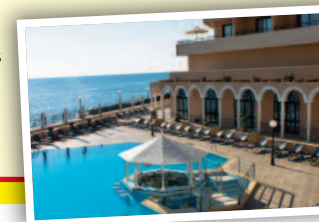
