2014 FSN ANNUAL MEETING FACULTY



Dr. Gerald B. Appel is Director of Clinical Nephrology at Columbia University Medical Center at The New York-Presbyterian Hospital, New York, New York, and is a tenured Professor of Clinical Medicine at Columbia University College of Physicians and Surgeons.

He is Chief of the Glomerular Kidney Disease Center at Columbia U. He received his undergraduate BA from Cornell University graduating in three years with distinction in all subjects and as a member of phi beta kappa. He received his medical degree from Albert Einstein College of Medicine, Bronx, New York, in 1972., where he was elected to the medical honor society Alpha Omega Alpha. He completed his internship and residency in Internal Medicine at Columbia Presbyterian Medical Center. He then completed fellowships in Nephrology at both Columbia-Presbyterian (1975-1976) and at Yale-New Haven Medical Center, New Haven, Connecticut (1976-1978).

Dr Appel has been listed in New York Magazine as one of the “Best Doctors in New York” annually between 1992 and 2010, and is listed in “Best Doctors in America,” and also in “How to Find the Best Doctors in N.Y. Metro Area.” He is an associate editor of Clinical JASN and of Up-To-Date. Dr. Appel is a member of numerous societies and has served on the Medical Advisory Board and as the Chairman of the Research Committee of the National Kidney Foundation of New York and New Jersey and The Kidney and Urology Foundation of America, as a past president of the New York Society of Nephrology, and as Chair of the Council of Glomerulonephritis of the National Kidney Foundation of the US. He is the director of many courses including The Columbia U Internal Medicine Course in NYC, Renal Biopsy in Medical Diseases of the Kidney in NYC, and The Treatment of Glomerular Diseases at the annual American Society of Nephrology meetings. Dr Appel has authored and co-authored almost 300 peer-reviewed articles and book chapters.



Dr. William M. Bennett is Medical Director of Transplantation, and Director of Renal Research, at Legacy Health Systems in Portland, Oregon. With more than 40 years of experience, Dr. Bennett is an expert in kidney transplantation.

Dr. Bennett received his medical degree from Northwestern University, Chicago. He was inducted into Alpha Omega Alpha. Following his residency in internal medicine at Northwestern University, Dr. Bennett served as chief resident, internal medicine at the University of Oregon Medical School, Portland. Dr. Bennett completed a fellowship in nephrology at Massachusetts General Hospital, Boston. He retired as a Professor at Oregon Health & Sciences University in 1999. Dr. Bennett is the current Editor-in-Chief Emeritus of the Clinical Journal of the American Society of Nephrology.

Dr. Bennett is an active clinician, researcher and educator. He is board certified and recertified in

internal medicine, nephrology, clinical pharmacology and is considered a specialist in clinical hypertension. He has been the principal investigator for multiple clinical studies. He has more than 460 peer-reviewed publications to his credit and has contributed to 170 books and chapters. He serves on numerous advisory boards. Dr. Bennett is a Master of the American College of Physicians, and a Fellow of the American Society of Nephrology and has been its past president. Dr. Bennett has been honored numerous times for his contributions to the medical profession, including the Polycystic Kidney Research Foundation Jared J. Grantham Distinguished Achievement Award, the Belding Scribner Award of the American Society of Nephrology, the Kidney Association of Oregon First Gift of Life Award and the Medical Research Foundation of Oregon Discovery Award and Prize. He has been identified as a nationally ranked top physician by Portland's Top Doctors, America's Top Doctors and Best Doctors in America.

Dr. Brian Kiss came to Florida Blue in 2006 with extensive experience in clinical medicine, medical education and health care management, and he has been a fulltime faculty member at the Albert

Einstein College of Medicine and Columbia University. Dr. Kiss received his M.D. from Einstein and trained in Internal Medicine and Nephrology at Columbia



Debra Lawson, CPC is a certified professional coder and a nephrology consultant. Ms. Lawson serves on the RPA's Health Care Payment Committee. She also serves on a subcommittee that assists RPA members with nephrology coding and documentation issues. Ms. Lawson is a contributor to RPA's publication, The Renal Physicians Guide to Nephrology

Practice. She has been a seminar leader for RPA's audio conferences on CKD billing and coding, as well as a speaker at RPA's annual meeting on various topics including billing, coding and chart auditing. She brings more than 25 years of experience to her nephrology billing, coding and documentation knowledge base.



Dr. Glen Markowitz received his undergraduate training at Brandeis University and then graduated from Albert Einstein College of Medicine in 1994 where he was elected to the Alpha Omega Alpha honor society. After completing his residency in Anatomic Pathology at Albert Einstein in 1997, he came to Columbia University to train as a renal pathology fellow under Dr. Vivette D'Agati. At the completion of his fellowship in 1998, he joined the faculty as an Assistant Professor of Clinical Pathology at Columbia

and was promoted to Associate Professor in 2002. Dr. Markowitz is a past recipient of the Renal Pathology Society's Young Investigator Award. In his seven years on faculty at Columbia, he has published 84 papers and has played an active role in teaching medical students for which he has been a finalist for multiple teaching awards. Dr Markowitz has played a vital role in the expansion of the renal pathology laboratory which now processes 2700 renal biopsies per year.

Dr. Marc A. Pohl is currently Head of the Section of Clinical Hypertension and Nephrology, Department of Nephrology and Hypertension at the Cleveland Clinic Foundation, and holds the Ray W. Gifford, Jr., M.D. Endowed Chair in Hypertension.

After graduating from Amherst College, Dr. Pohl received his medical degree from Case Western Reserve University School of Medicine, and then interned and completed a residency at University Hospitals of Cleveland, followed by a senior residency and nephrology fellowships at Massachusetts General Hospital, Boston University Medical Center and Boston City Hospital. Dr. Pohl has been affiliated with the Cleveland Clinic Foundation since 1973; his appointments

have included heading the home dialysis training program, and serving as program director of the Department of Nephrology and Hypertension.

Dr. Pohl has been a co-investigator in several major trials, including the Collaborative Study of Adult Nephrotic Syndrome and Adult Glomerular Disease, the Lupus Nephritis Collaborative Study Group, the North American Adult Nephrotic Syndrome, and the Collaborative Study Group. He is the author of more than 80 articles, 90 abstracts, and numerous book chapters. Dr. Pohl actively participates as a faculty member of many national and international symposia and postgraduate courses in nephrology and hypertension.



Dr. Rebecca Schmidt professor and chief of the West Virginia University Section of Nephrology in the WVU School of Medicine Department of Medicine, is currently serving as the president of the Renal Physicians Association (RPA), a national medical specialty association that represents and serves the interests of nephrology practitioners in their pursuit and delivery of quality kidney care.

Elected to RPA's Board of Directors in March 2007, Dr. Schmidt has reached a milestone in RPA's history as the first woman to serve as president-elect and now president of the organization.

Dr. Schmidt received her Doctor of Osteopathic Medicine degree from the University of Osteopathic Medicine and Health Sciences in Des Moines, Iowa, and completed an internal medicine residency and nephrology fellowship at Henry Ford Hospital in Detroit, Mich., prior to joining the faculty of WVU in 1993.

She is a Healthgrades Recognized Doctor and a recipient of several prestigious honors. During her esteemed career, she has published manuscripts, contributed to several books on kidney disease and has presented and published more than 70 abstracts.
