



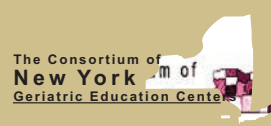

Course

A four-day clinically-based intensive course in geriatrics and palliative medicine taught by leading experts in both fields providing updates on geriatric syndromes and palliative medicine and the latest research and treatments. Each day consists of five large group sessions (four on Wednesday) and three interactive workshops designed to provide both practical experience with the large group material as well as to cover other content areas. Each workshop session has a choice of six to seven workshops with a balance of Geriatrics and Palliative Medicine choices. Some workshops are repeated based on demand and all workshops are case-based. Comprehensive Board Review Q&A sessions will take place during lunch three days.

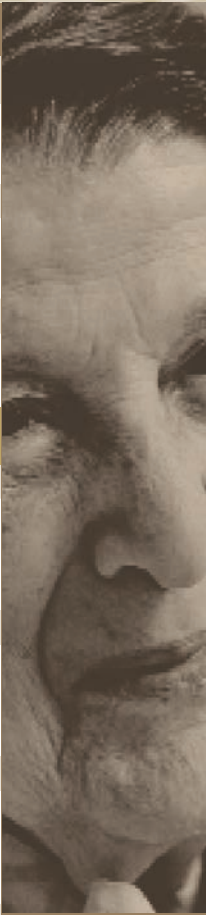
