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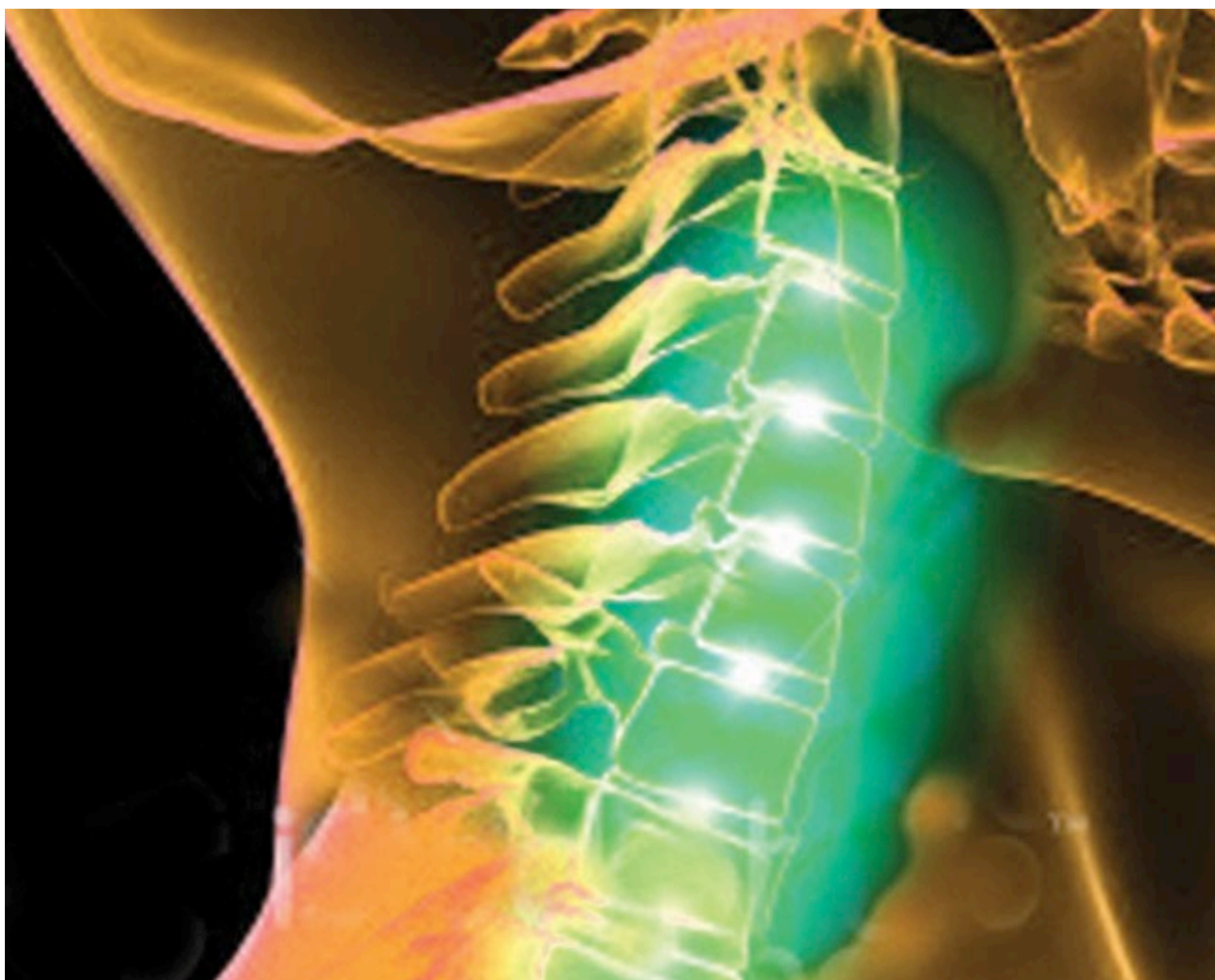

Conference Aims

This course aims to build on the successes of the last five years and will explore the issues surrounding marginal control in mucosal and cutaneous malignancy of the head and neck. The day will consist of evidence-based sessions that will consider the management of a number of conditions in varying anatomical sites and derive an algorithm of care based on the currently available literature. The afternoon concludes with this year's invited lecture which will consider how surgeon level reporting in cardiac surgery might influence head and neck disciplines.
