COURSE DESCRIPTION

This symposium provides a didactic review of several common and uncommon entities all of which are connected by their association with vascular imaging, including aortic pathology, head and neck malignancy, liver disease and neurodegenerative disease. Each topic is presented in a didactic, lecture format, followed by questions and answers. The course attempts to address changes in vascular imaging, acquisition and interpretation, as well as related interventional techniques. It addresses new ideas in vascular imaging, including TAVR and several types of transplant imaging as well as introducing newer techniques for vascular interventions not generally performed in the community. Embolization techniques of head and neck vascular tumors in particular are novel ideas that may save patients from debilitating, deforming surgeries. In the case of porto-mesenteric thrombosis, interventional radiology takes a leading role when few other treatment options exist. Neuroradiology topics include the current status of Alzheimer's disease, diagnosis and treatment, and functional imaging of the brain, which have undergone dramatic evolution.

EDUCATIONAL OBJECTIVES

By the end of the course, participants will be able to:

- Demonstrate new and innovative radiology imaging techniques related to vascular pathology and treatment.
- Discuss various techniques on direct patient care involving radiology procedures.
- Explain new cutting edge application in MRI, CT and US.

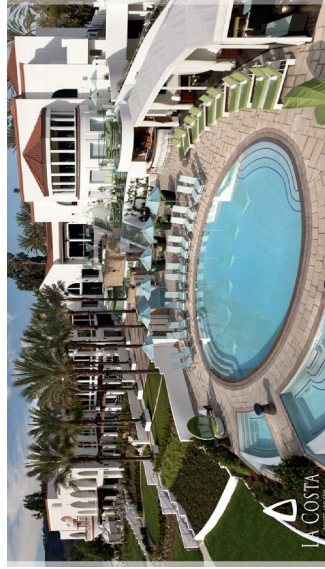
