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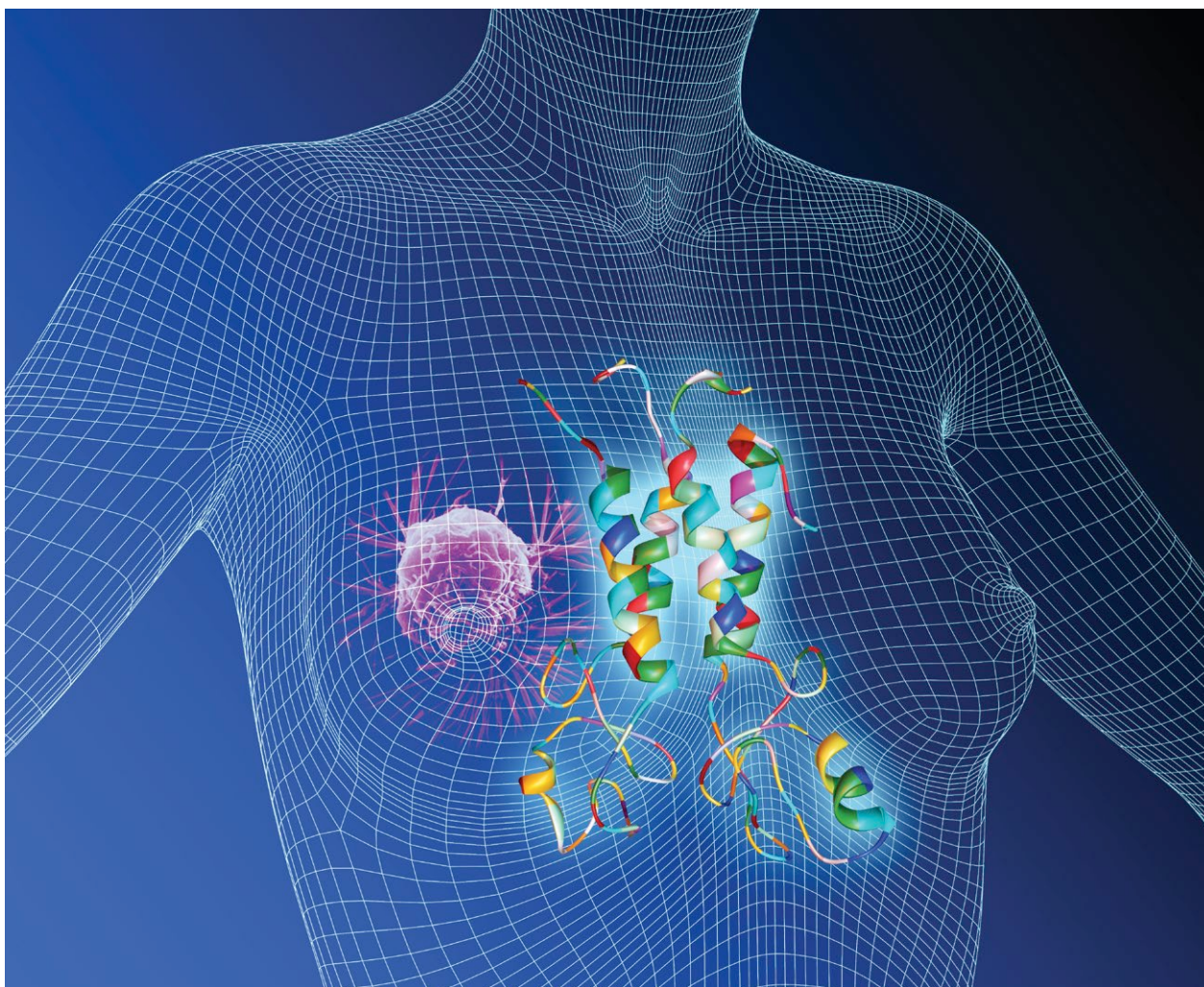

Dear Colleagues,

I am pleased to announce that we are holding the 7th Annual Royal Marsden Breast Cancer Meeting on Friday 3rd October 2014. As in previous years the aim of our meeting is to provide an update on what is new, clinically relevant and indeed controversial in the management of patients with breast cancer. The role of surgery, particularly after neoadjuvant chemotherapy, is a particular area of controversy and I am delighted to say that we have as our guest speaker and Cridlan lecturer Dr Monica Morrow, Chief and Chair of Clinical Oncology, Memorial Sloan Kettering Cancer Centre. Dr Morrow is a world leader in breast cancer surgery and is renowned for her forthright views.

As always, we have selected what we believe to be some of the most important current issues and we have asked our experts from the Royal Marsden to address these and to define how they relate to current practice. A feature of our past meetings has been in-depth discussion on each topic and we plan to leave plenty of time for this. There will be ample opportunity to ask questions and to express your own views. The meeting is open to all professionals involved in the challenge of looking after women with breast cancer including or in particular clinicians and senior nurses.

Due to the success of previous meetings and the positive feedback we have received, we are again going for a large venue this year at The Royal College of Physicians. We very much hope that you will join us for this exciting and challenging event.
