Once again we extend cordial welcome to you all and look forward to your active participation in NAPCON 2014 in one of the most beautiful tourist city of India.

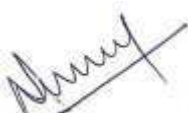

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TOURIST ATTRACTIONS

FULL DAY AGRA CITY TOUR



Agra, the city of Taj Mahal, a poem in white marble built in the 16th century by Emperor Shahjahan as a monument of love. Agra was once the capital of the Mughals and the relics of their glory are scattered all over the city. From the Taj Mahal to the massive Agra Fort, the delicately carved Itmad-ud-Daulah's tomb to Akbar's deserted majestic capital Fatehpur Sikri; Agra is India's best-known destination and a must on any program.

JAIPUR

Jaipur is a major tourist destination in India. In the 2008 Conde Nast Traveller Readers Choice Survey, Jaipur was ranked the 7th best place to visit in Asia. There are various places in Jaipur which attract visitors on a very large scale & Few of them are Hawa Mahal, Amer Palace Nahargarh Fort and City Palace. Hawa Mahal is a palace built of red and pink sand stone. The palace forms a part of the City Palace, and extends to the Zenana or women's chambers. Amer Palace is located in Amer, 11 kilometres from Jaipur. It is the principal tourist attractions in the Jaipur area, located high on a hill.



BHARATPUR

Bharatpur 29 sq. km piece of marshland is one of the finest bird sanctuaries in the world, with over 360 species. It used to be the hunting estate of the Maharajas of Bharatpur and the daily shoot was reputed to be as high as 100,000 birds. It is especially good time from Nov to Feb when it is frequented by Northern hemisphere migratory birds.



RANTHAMBORE

Ranthambore National Park is one of the largest national parks in northern India. It is situated in Sawai Madhopur district of south eastern Rajasthan and was established as the Sawai Madhopur Game Sanctuary in 1955 by the Government of India and was declared one of the Project Tiger reserves in 1973. Ranthambore became a national park in 1980. Ranthambore wildlife sanctuary is known for its tigers and is one of the best places in India to see these majestic predators in the jungle. Tigers can be easily spotted even during the daytime. The best time to visit Ranthambore National Park is in November and May when the nature of the dry deciduous forests makes sightings common. The park lies at the edge of a plateau and is bounded to the north by the Banas River and to the south by the Chambal River. The park covers an area of 392 sq km and is known for its tiger population.



Mathura Vrindavan & Gokul

Vrindavan is also a small place lying adjacent to Mathura. Vrindavan is the place where Lord Krishna spent his youth playing with Gopis and Sakhas. After sightseeing of Mathura & Vrindavan drive to Gokul where Nand Gopal was sheltered in Yashoda Maiya's home in secrecy to escape the wrath of tyrant Kansha. Then to Goverdhan – where Lord Krishna held aloft 'Giriraj', the sandstone hill on his finger for seven days and nights to protect the people of Braj.

How to Reach Agra

Train

Agra is located in between the main train lines from Delhi to Mumbai and from Delhi to Chennai. It is like a junction and this makes Agra easy to reach by train from almost anywhere. From Delhi, you can reach Agra by train in about 2-3 hours by Bhopal Shatabdi, Bhopal Express, Malwa Express, Gondwana Express, Jabalpur – JammuTawi Express, etc. Agra has three railway stations. The main one is Agra Cantt.

Road

Driving to Agra is also easy and comfortable with new modern highways. From Delhi you can take the NH2 highway (200 kms), from Jaipur you can take NH 11 (255kms), from Gwalior the National highway which is 120 kms and from Lucknow NH2 which is 285 kms. The main bus stations in Agra are Idgah and ISBT and there are scheduled, air-conditioned and luxury buses from Delhi, Jaipur, Gwalior, Jhansi and Lucknow.

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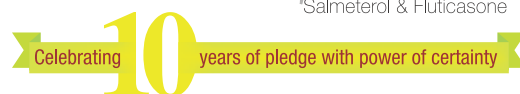

4. Alternatively the abstracts can be submitted online at <http://napcon2014.com/abstracts-submission.php> However, please ensure that a signed hard copy of the submission reaches the Scientific Secretary before the deadline.
5. Please restrict your abstract to a maximum of 300 words including tables(excluding title and author information)
6. A structured abstract is preferred (Background, Methods, Results, Conclusion and Clinical implications)
7. Financial disclosures if any should be clearly made at the end of the abstract.
8. Presenting author must be a registered delegate. All abstracts have to be accompanied with registration number (or registration form along with the applicable registration fees)
9. DEADLINE for submission of abstract is September 20th 2014. Abstract received after this date will not be considered for presentation.
10. Those who wish to be considered for award session should clearly indicate in which award session they are contesting.
11. Presenter for Young Scientist Award should be first author, presenter and below 35 years . please provide age proof along with abstract submission.
