Located along the Douro river estuary in northern Portugal, Porto is one of the oldest European centers, and registered as a World Heritage Site by UNESCO in 1996. Its settlement dates back many centuries, when it was an outpost of the Roman Empire. Its Latin name, Portus Cale, has been referred to as the origin for the name "Portugal", based on transliteration and oral evolution from Latin. In Portuguese the name of the city is spelled with a definite article as "*o Porto*" (English: *the port*). Consequently, its English name evolved from a misinterpretation of the oral pronunciation and referred to as "*Oporto*" in modern literature and by many speakers.

One of Portugal's internationally famous exports, port wine, is named for Porto, since the metropolitan area, and in particular the wine cellars of Vila Nova de Gaia, were responsible for the production and export of the fortified wine.

From the picturesque streets of downtown Oporto to the churches and monuments which offer spots of unrivalled beauty, meandering along romantic routes, cruises on the River Douro, visits to the port wine Cellars, discovering Sea Life, the imposing presence of the Stock Exchange Palace, the architecture of Casa da Música or the Serralves Museum collection of modern art, there are many reasons to join us at ERASMUS course and visit Porto.
