

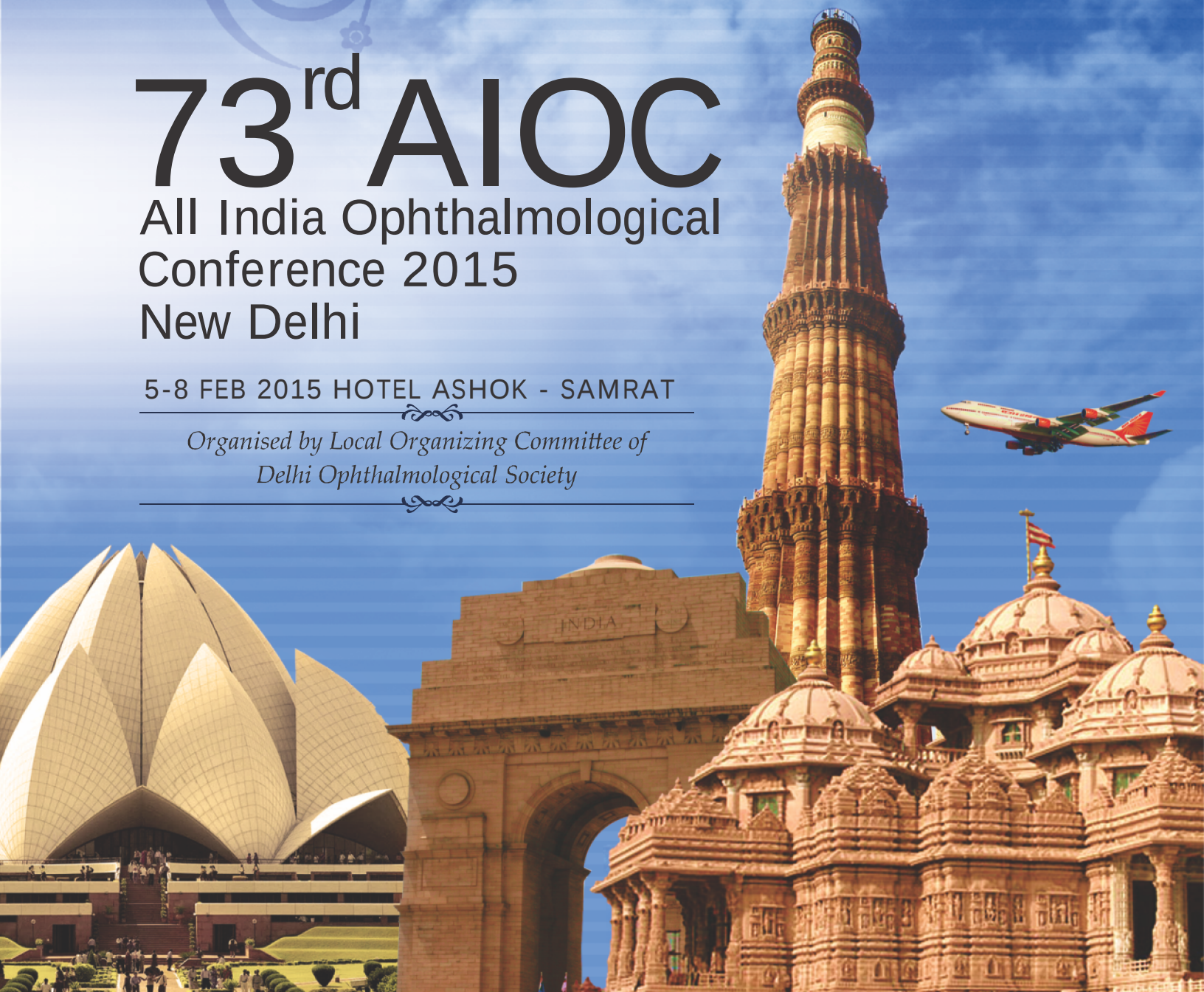

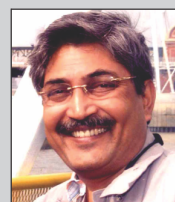

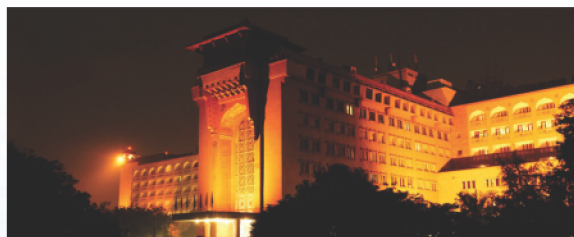

ALL INDIA OPHTHALMOLOGICAL CONFERENCE

AKSHARDHAM

This temple in New Delhi epitomizes 10,000 years of Indian culture in all its breathtaking grandeur, beauty, wisdom and bliss. It brilliantly showcases the essence of India's ancient architecture, traditions and timeless spiritual messages.

INDIA GATE

The towering archways of India Gate at the center of New Delhi is a war memorial, built in memory of the Indian soldiers who lost their lives fighting for the British Army in World War I. At night it glows warmly under floodlights.

QUTAB MINAR

It is a soaring, 73 m-high tower of victory, built in 1193 by Qutab-ud-din Aibak. The QutubMinar is made of red sandstone and marble located at Mehrauli, New Delhi.

LOTUS TEMPLE

Built in the shape of a lotus flower and located to the east of Nehru place, it is the last of seven Major Bahai's temples built around the world. Completed in 1986, it is made up of pure white marble and set among the lush green landscaped gardens.

RED FORT

Built in 1638 and also called Lal Qila, the red sandstone walls of this massive monument situated at Old Delhi is a reminder of the magnificent power and pomp of the Mughal emperors. An evening sound and light show re-creates events in India's history connected with the fort.

JAMA MASJID

This great mosque of old Delhi is the largest in India, with a courtyard capable of holding 25,000 devotees. It was begun in 1644 and ended up being the final architectural extravagance of Shah Jahan, the Mughal emperor.
