Neurovascular disease is the number one cause of permanent adult disability in the United States. Exciting new treatments have shown promise, not only in preventing subsequent strokes, but reversing the effects of acute stroke. The evaluation and management of acute stroke, transient ischemic attack (TIAs), and cerebral aneurysms are in rapid evolution.
