We invite you to work at the Meeting and spend time relaxing in the streets, cultural centres and restaurants.

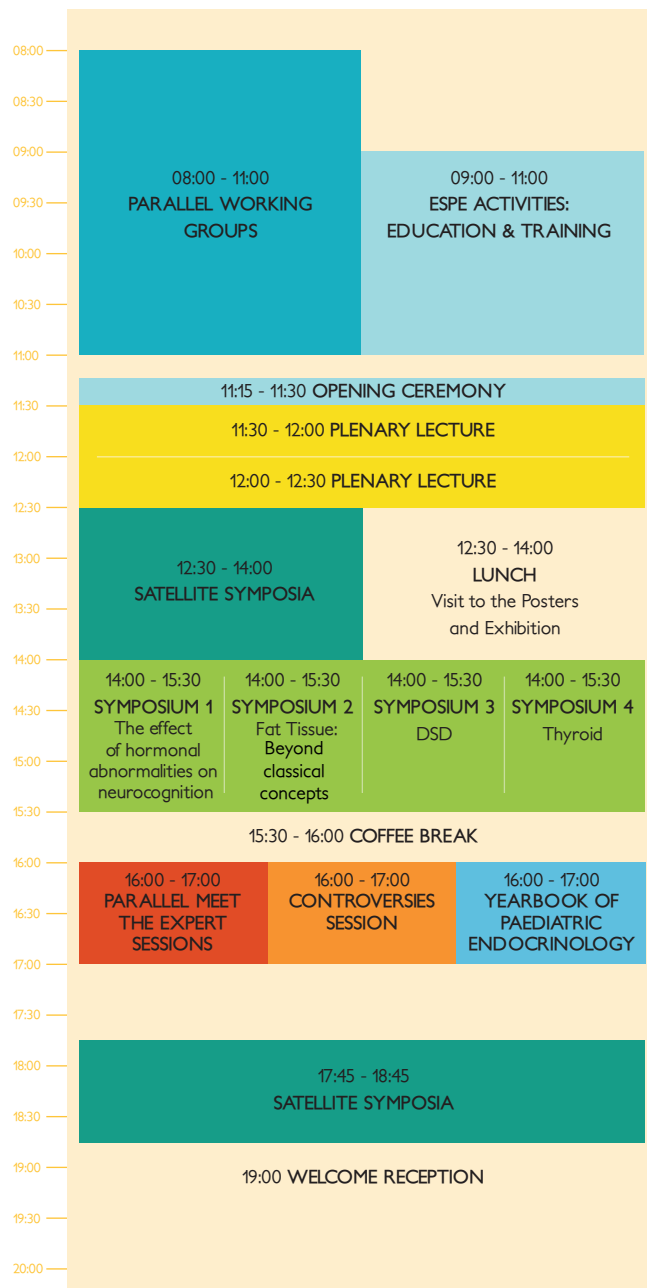

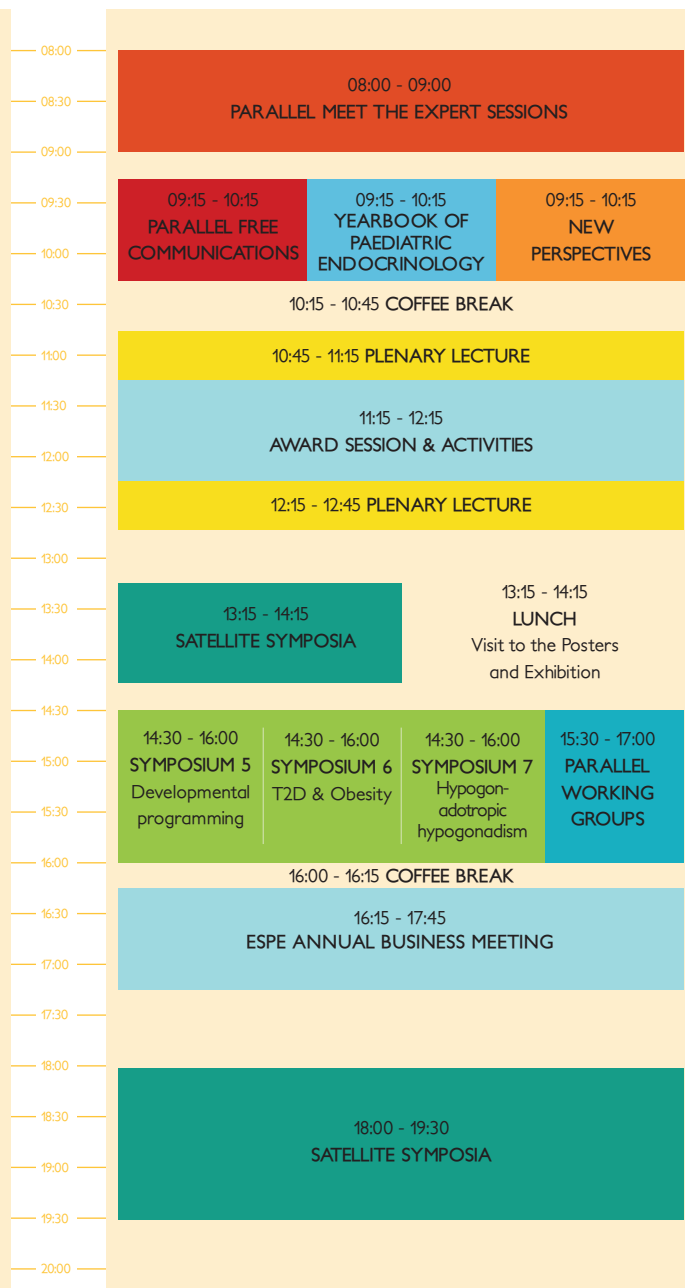
