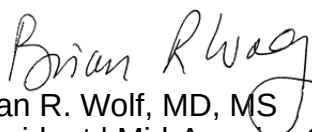

2026 MAOA MEETING OBJECTIVES

- 03 ● Review surgical techniques and postoperative outcomes in shoulder and elbow arthroplasty, including preoperative planning, implant selection, and management of complications.
- 04 ● Discuss best practices in the diagnosis, treatment, and rehabilitation of sports-related knee injuries, including anterior cruciate ligament reconstruction, meniscal repair, and cartilage restoration.
- 05 ● Review evidence-based approaches in pediatric orthopedics, including fracture management, congenital deformities, and strategies to improve efficiency and safety in care delivery.
- 06 ● Recognize preoperative and intraoperative factors that influence outcomes in hip preservation procedures, such as periacetabular osteotomy and arthroscopic interventions.
- 07 ● Review advances in the surgical and non-surgical management of spine trauma and degenerative conditions, with focus on alignment restoration and reduction of complications.
- 08 ● Discuss treatment strategies and reconstructive options for complex hand and wrist injuries, including advances in fracture fixation, tendon reconstruction, and nerve repair.
- 09 ● Evaluate current management principles for foot and ankle pathology, including trauma, deformity correction, and the integration of biologic and technological innovations.
- 10 ● Review contemporary approaches to musculoskeletal oncology, emphasizing limb-sparing procedures, implant durability, and multidisciplinary collaboration.
- 11 ● Explore the role of emerging technologies in orthopedic practice, including artificial intelligence, digital surgical planning, simulation training, and outcome tracking.
- 12 ● Enhance understanding of clinical outcomes research, value-based care, and innovations in orthopedic education, to promote continuous improvement in patient outcomes and professional development.

Jan Jensen currently serves as the P. Sue Beckwith, M.D. Head Women's Basketball Coach at the University of Iowa, a role she was named to on May 13, 2024. She is in her 25th season with the Hawkeyes women's basketball program, and brings 36 years of experience in women's college basketball as both a player and a coach.

Over her long tenure at Iowa, Jan has been a nationally-recognized contributor, especially in the area of recruiting. Her role as recruiting coordinator and work with post players have helped shape the Hawkeye program's sustained success. Notably, under her recruiting leadership Iowa has landed

high-level classes (including four McDonald's All-Americans) and has achieved numerous team milestones.

Her influence extends deeply into player development: Jan has guided post-players who attained All-Big Ten honors and even national recognition. For instance, she coached Megan Gustafson to become the first Big Ten player in history to be named a consensus National Player of the Year. She also helped shape the rise of Caitlin Clark, whose exceptional career flourished during Jan's tenure.

Beyond her on-court achievements, Jan brings a strong commitment to leadership and community engagement. A native of Kimballton, Iowa, she graduated from Drake University in 1991 with a degree in Public Relations and later earned a Master's in Higher Education. Off the court she has been active in fundraising and service, including leading campaigns for the United Way of Johnson County that exceeded \$2 million and philanthropic efforts recognized via accolades such as the Corridor Business Journal's "Women of Influence" award.

Jan Jensen, now in her first year as the Head Women's Basketball Coach at Iowa, brings more than three decades of experience as a player and coach and has been a central architect of the Hawkeyes' rise to national prominence. A renowned recruiter and long-time associate head coach, she helped lead Iowa to 22 postseason appearances, multiple Big Ten championships, and back-to-back NCAA title game runs. Known for developing elite post players, Jensen coached national standouts including Megan Gustafson and played a key role in recruiting and mentoring Caitlin Clark, one of the most decorated players in college basketball history. A former national scoring leader herself at Drake, Jensen has also made meaningful impact off the court through community leadership and philanthropy, reflecting her deep connection to the state and to the growth of the Iowa program.

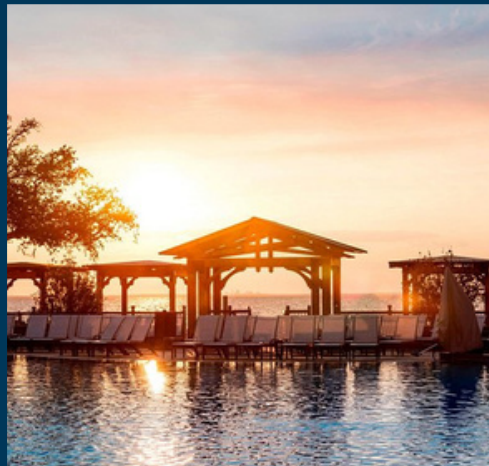
