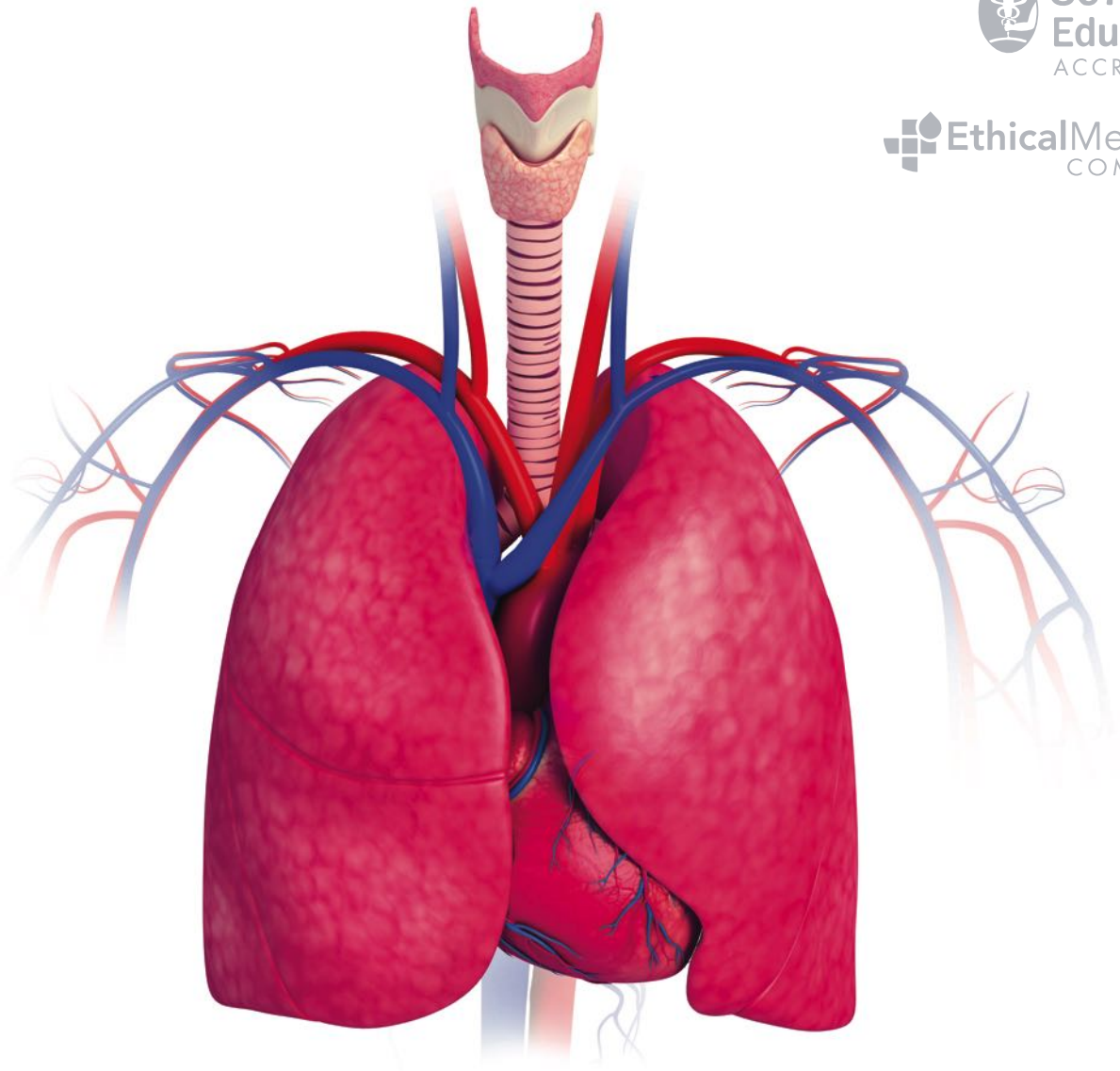

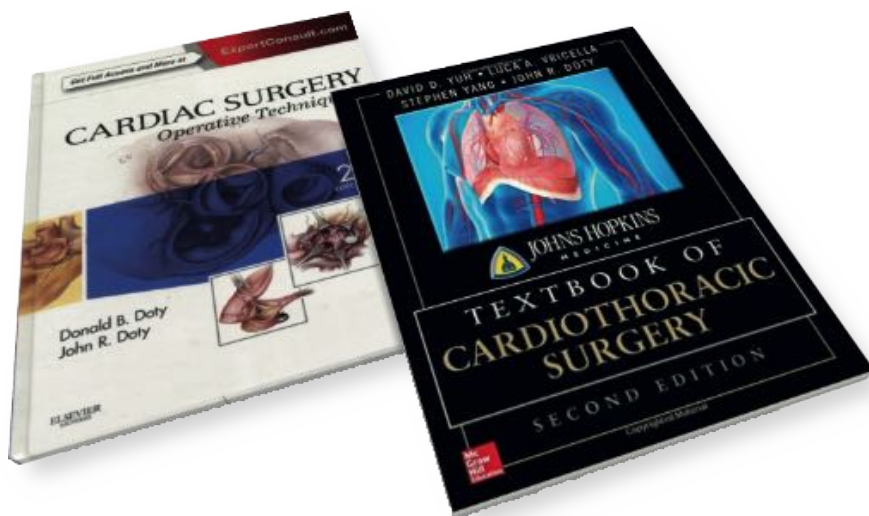

Upon completion of the course, participants should be able to:

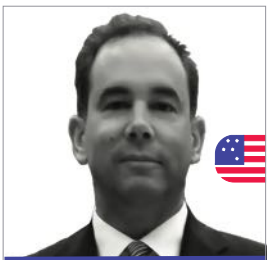
- Identify strengths and weaknesses in their knowledge of cardiovascular and thoracic surgery.

08: CARDIOTHORACIC LEARNING WEB APP

The London Core Review web app was created to allow delegates to continue learning our material beyond our course events and also to allow those who cannot attend our courses in person to benefit from our course. Our web app has all the course videos logically laid out with emphasis on high quality illustrated graphics and navigation. The responsive web app is designed for to work on all kinds of devices. Four day delegates receive complementary 12 month access. Subscription is available for new and past users.



We have recently implemented quizzes within our web app which allows members to test their knowledge before taking the video course and take the followup quiz after.
