



# Core Skills: ENT Facial Plastic Surgery

The Core Skills: ENT Facial Plastic Surgery Workshop will provide ENT and Plastic Surgery trainees with increased operative experience and the opportunity to consolidate knowledge and skills in a range of techniques in facial plastic surgery. This hands-on cadaveric workshop will reinforce knowledge of anatomy and provides the opportunity to practise a range of facial plastic procedures not commonly performed by trainees in clinical practice.

Hands-on dissection and pairing of participants of similar skill levels enables discussion and group learning under expert supervision.

### Demonstration and Practical Cadaveric Sessions

The workshop will feature a comprehensive, highly practical full-day program. It features demonstrations by expert faculty utilising the latest 3D visualisation technology across a range of open surgical procedures, followed by extensive cadaveric practical sessions focusing on the following:

- Otoplasty - Anatomy and assessment. Mustarde suturing and anterior scoring
- Conchal cartilage harvest
- Rhinoplasty
- Blepharoplasty – upper and lower, lateral canthoplasty
- Facelifts and endobrow lift
- Free practical session allowing practise of workshop program procedure/s of choice

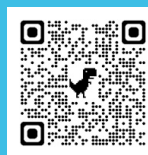
