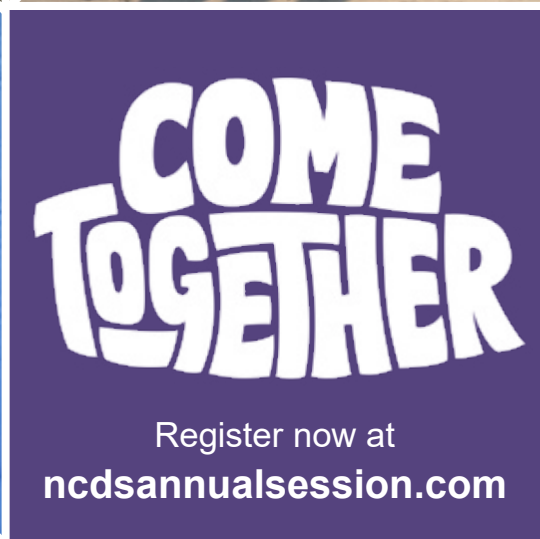

SUNRISE YOGA

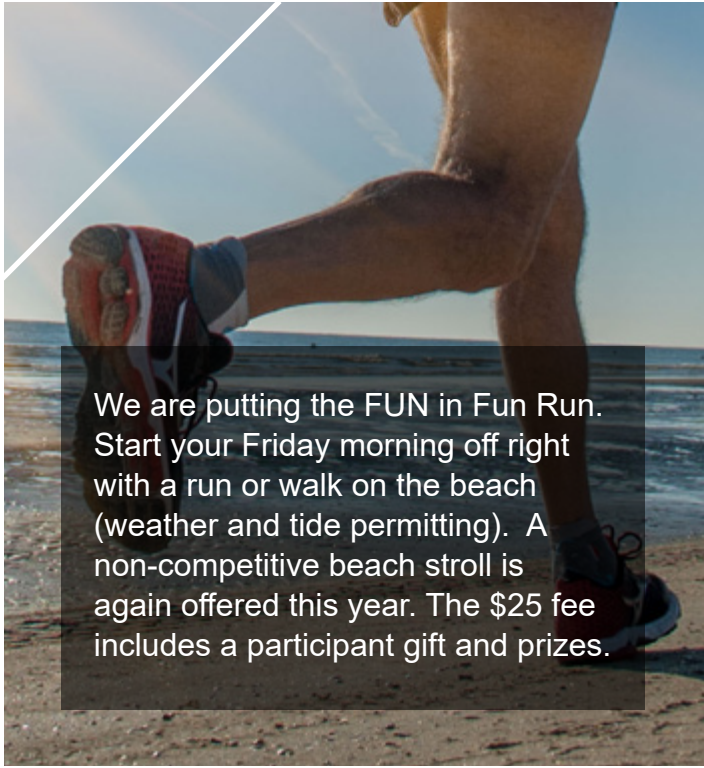
THURSDAY MORNING ON THE BEACH
