PRECONFERENCE B: Breast Cancer Survivorship Tools to Cope and Move On

This Preconference will address complex challenges in the management of breast cancer survivors, including treatment options for menopausal symptoms, surveillance with imaging and the role of lifestyle modification to reduce breast cancer recurrence. Attendees will learn how BReast CAncer susceptibility gene (BRCA) carriers can be managed and how to address the impact of these interventions on their quality of life.

- ▶ Describe surveillance options after breast cancer.
- ▶ Identify common co-morbidities that often accompany survivorship, such as insulin-resistance, coronary/cerebral artery disease, hypertension, weight gain, and muscle loss.
