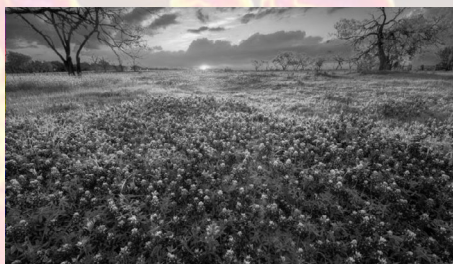


Top 10 San Antonio Attractions

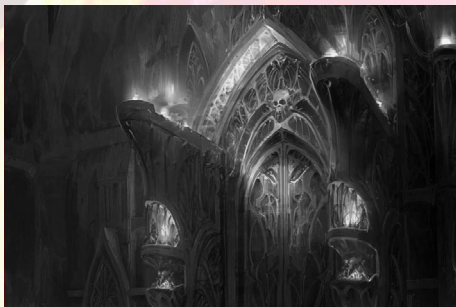
