Management of special populations including the pregnant patient and those with complications of therapy will be discussed.

WHO SHOULD ATTEND THIS COURSE?

This symposium is designed for gastroenterologists, colorectal surgeons, internists, and advanced practice professionals who participate in the management of this complicated patient population.

OBJECTIVES

Upon completion of this course, attendees will refine their approach to:

- appropriate type and timing of therapy for the patient with moderate to severe IBD;
- managing therapy in the patient with malignancy and IBD;
- recognition and management of colonic dysplasia;
- the use of Complementary Alternative Medicine;
- the management of fistulas;
- recommending health care maintenance for patients with IBD;
- understanding the rates of IBD in diverse populations;
- prescribing medical therapy for the pregnant patient with IBD.
