We are looking forward to welcome you in Verona, a spectacular city, a key part of Italian history, a symbol of art and culture, and a recognized UNESCO heritage.



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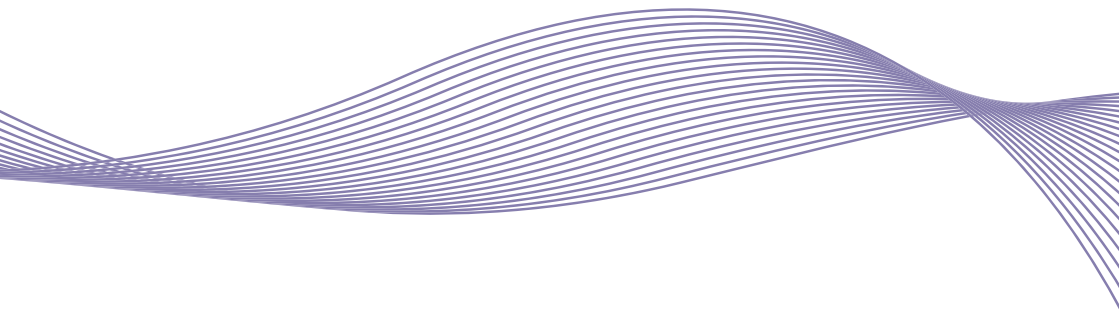
