Title page of the abstract should include author's name, title of the paper, suggested sub-themes, designation, institution affiliation, mailing address, contact numbers and email-id. Abstract should be sent to info@sarvasumana.in. Guidelines for the preparation of full paper will be communicated along with the acceptance of the abstracts.
