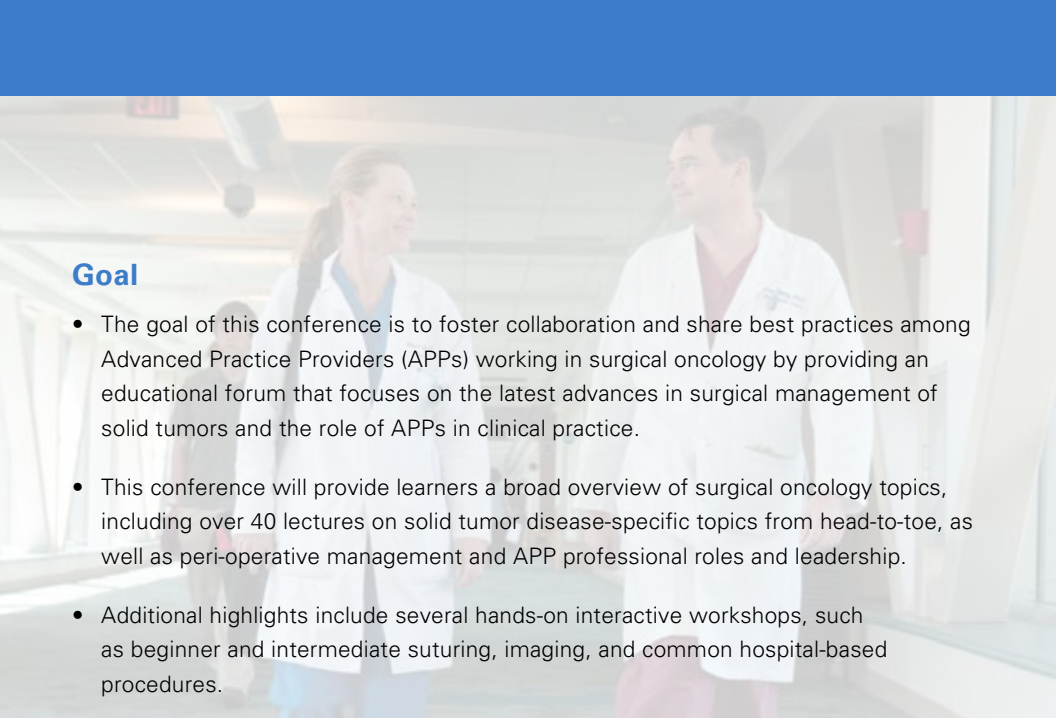

Goal

- The goal of this conference is to foster collaboration and share best practices among Advanced Practice Providers (APPs) working in surgical oncology by providing an educational forum that focuses on the latest advances in surgical management of solid tumors and the role of APPs in clinical practice.
- This conference will provide learners a broad overview of surgical oncology topics, including over 40 lectures on solid tumor disease-specific topics from head-to-toe, as well as peri-operative management and APP professional roles and leadership.
- Additional highlights include several hands-on interactive workshops, such as beginner and intermediate suturing, imaging, and common hospital-based procedures.

Educational Objectives

After attending the conference, participants should be able to

- Describe recent advances in the surgical management of solid tumors originating from the following organ and/or disease sites: brain, spine, oropharynx, thyroid, lung, breast, esophagus, stomach, colon, rectum, liver, pancreas, prostate, kidney, bladder, ovary, skin, and bones (*knowledge, competence, performance, patient outcomes*)
- Demonstrate and perform common hospital-based procedures, including suturing, wound care, and bedside ultrasound (*knowledge, competence, performance, patient outcomes*)
- Describe fundamentals of solid tumor imaging, and how to review and interpret pertinent findings from computed tomography and magnetic

resonance imaging of the head, neck, chest, and abdomen (*knowledge, competence, performance*); and

- Examine and illustrate the changing role of the Advanced Practice Professionals in the delivery of oncology care for surgical patients (*knowledge, competence, performance*)

Target Audience

The target audience includes Physician Assistants, Nurse Practitioners, Clinical Nurse Specialists, RNs, CRNAs, and other healthcare professionals involved in the management of patients in surgical oncology.

Educational Method

Lectures – Case Presentations – Question and Answer Session – Panel Discussion – Poster Session – Hands-on Workshops
