The Duke – UNC Tobacco Treatment Specialist Training Program is a collaborative effort by the **Duke University Smoking Cessation Program**, the **University of North Carolina Tobacco Treatment Program**, and the **Tobacco Prevention and Control Branch, NC Division of Health and Human Services**, national leaders in tobacco treatment, education, policy, and research. The four-day on-site training--conducted by physicians, researchers, therapists, pharmacists, and public policy experts, all with expertise in tobacco use disorders--covers:

- **evidence-based tobacco use treatment, including pharmacotherapy and counseling strategies for individual and group treatment**
- **targeted skills in tobacco use disorder counseling, including motivational interviewing**
- **treatment planning exercises**
- **relapse prevention**
- **population-based tobacco use data and policy history, culture and context**
- **practical guidance on running a practice**

Participants who complete the training will receive 27.25 hours of CME credit and will be prepared to sit for the National Certificate in Tobacco Treatment Practice (NCTTP) exam offered by NAADAC, the Association for Addiction Professionals.

Diverse teams from health care and behavioral health systems are welcomed, as the goal is to increase systems approaches to evidence-based tobacco treatment.
