Advanced Colonoscopy Techniques

Course Description

- Utilize safe and effective bowel preparations and medication management for a spectrum of patient conditions and co-morbidities.
- Implement quality measures for colonoscopy and use these benchmarks to enhance colonoscopy practice.
- Adapt their practice to meet performance-based payment requirements.
- Increase their adenoma detection rates through the use of optimal withdrawal techniques, image-enhancement, chromoendoscopy, caps, and evolving scope technologies.
- Resect large, flat adenomas safely and completely, using a variety of tools and techniques including submucosal injection, loops, as well as piecemeal and en bloc mucosal resection.
- Reduce post-polypectomy complications by implementing safer techniques and interventions.
