PREGNANCY POLICY

If a pregnant guest has entered or will be entering their 24th week before or during the cruise, they are **NOT ALLOWED** to travel.

If a pregnant guest is less than 24 weeks, a physician's "Fit to Travel" note stating that they are in good health, not a high risk pregnancy, and not entering the 24th week must be presented at check-in and carried onboard.

MINIMUM AGE TO CRUISE

Children must be at **least six months old** by November 14, 2015, to go on the cruise. **Denial of boarding for children who do not satisfy this minimum age requirement may also result in the denial of boarding for one or more guests sailing with that child.** No refunds will be given as a result of the denial of boarding to an underage child or other accompanying guests.

PASSPORT AND VISA INFORMATION

GROUND TRANSPORTATION
