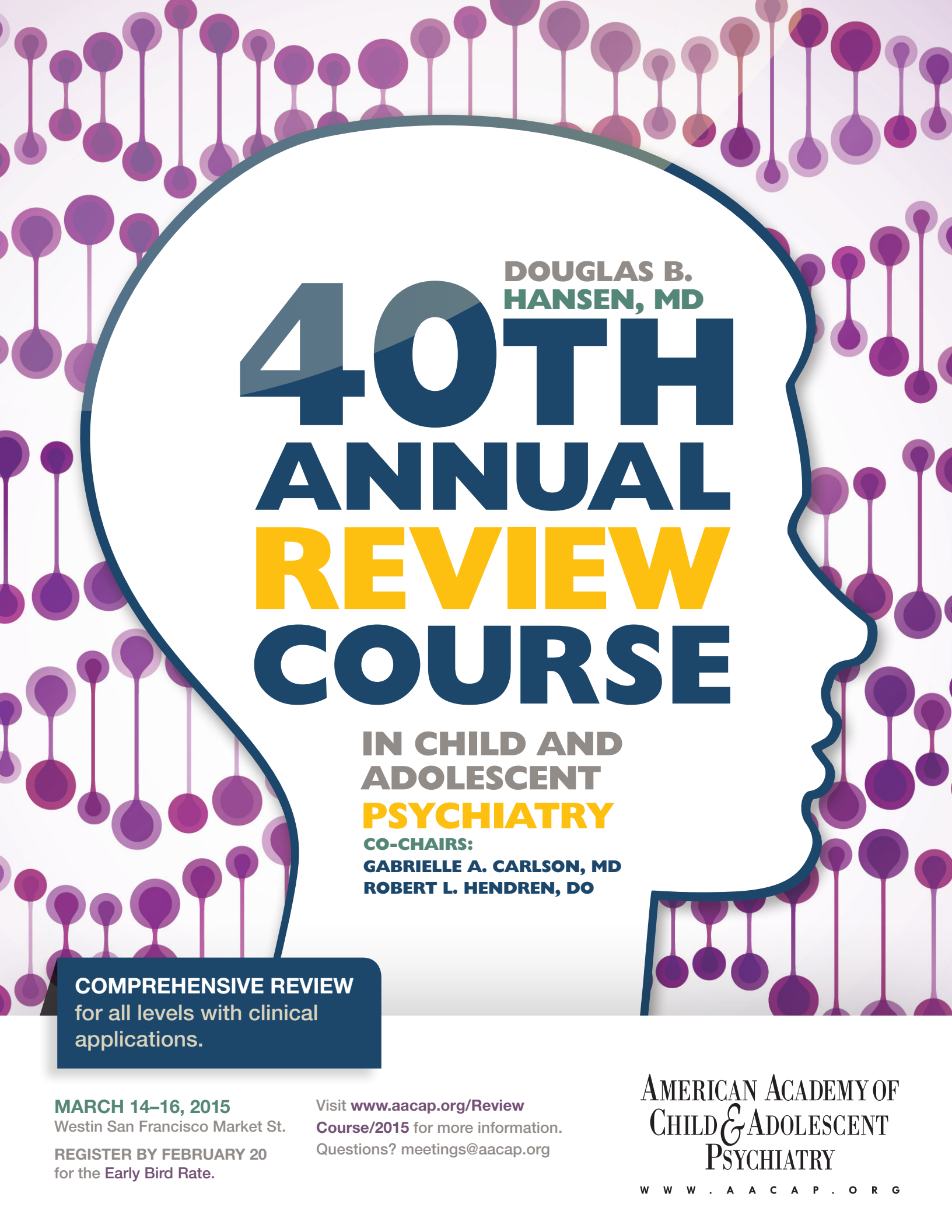

INSTITUTE GOALS AND OVERVIEW

AACAP's Douglas B. Hansen, MD, 40th Annual Review Course emphasizes the most recent material relevant to the general practice of child and adolescent psychiatry and serves as both an up-to-date review of child and adolescent psychiatry as well as addresses important clinical research.
