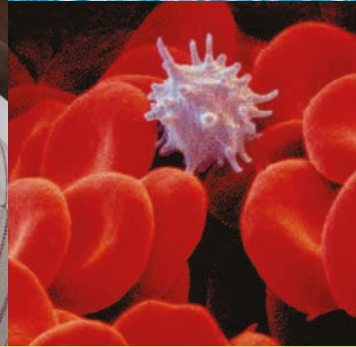
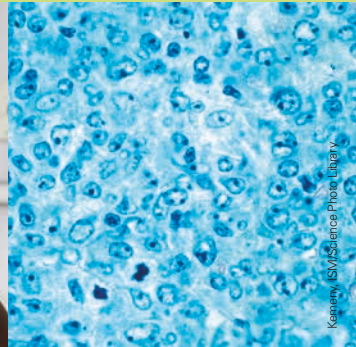
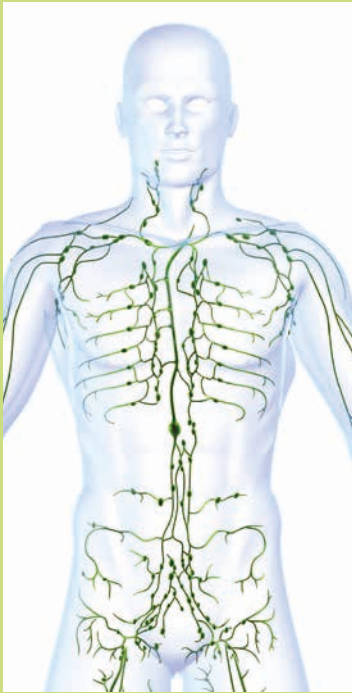

He undertook a DPhil in the molecular biology of Hodgkin / Reed-Sternberg cells and has current research interests in clinical trials, biomarker development, Hodgkin and high grade non-Hodgkin lymphoma.

Dr Chris Hatton is a consultant haematologist at Oxford University Hospitals. He has many years' experience dealing with lymphoproliferative conditions. He has a clinical interest in low-grade lymphomas and his scientific interests include microRNAs in lymphomagenesis. He is the author of a number of textbooks covering haematology and general medicine.
