### DESCRIPTION

The workshop will consist of an introductory 45 minute didactic lecture to familiarize the audience with the most updated guidelines for electronic fetal heart rate monitoring interpretation published by the NICHD Workshop in 2010. Following the

introductory lecture, Dr. Druzin will present short vignettes of real-life cases from his extensive library. Each case consists of a short clinical description, followed by a series of electronic fetal heart rate monitoring reproductions. The session is an interactive one. Dr. Druzin will interact with the audience and ask for their interpretation and advice during each vignettes.
