Business Meeting and Change of Officers

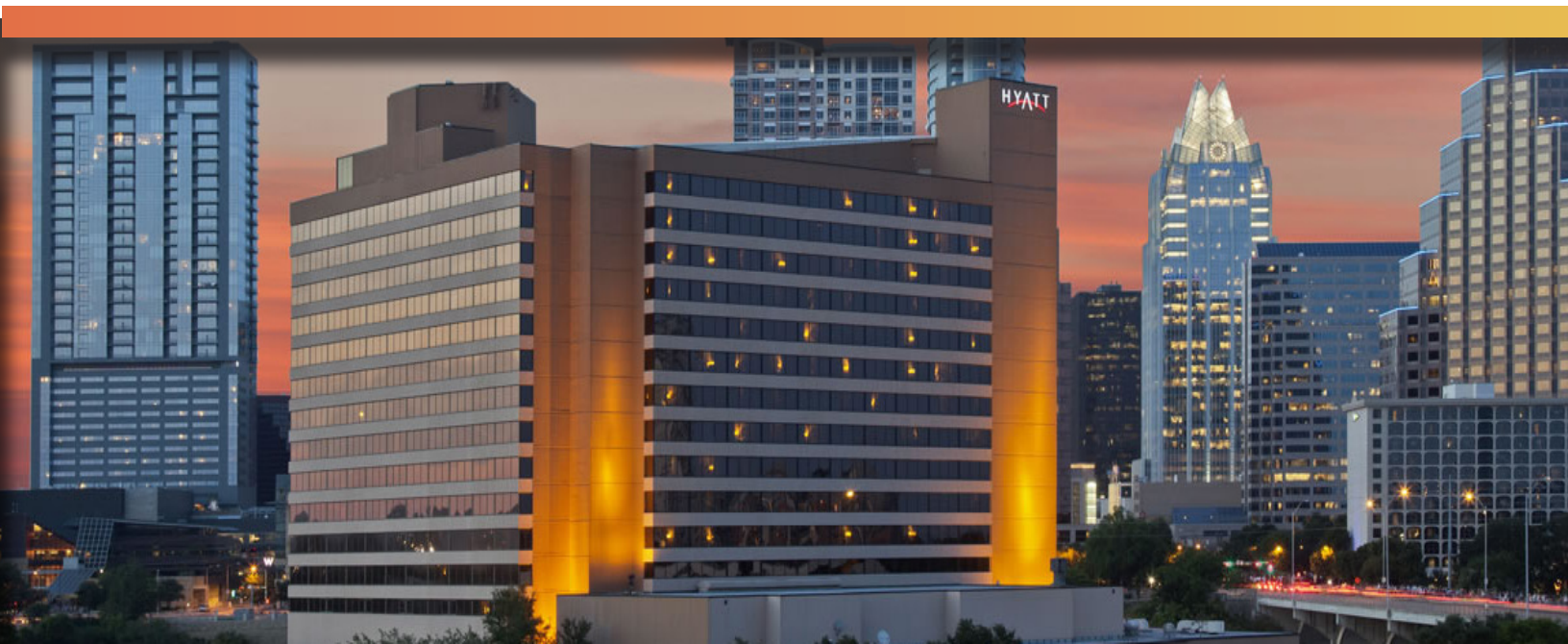
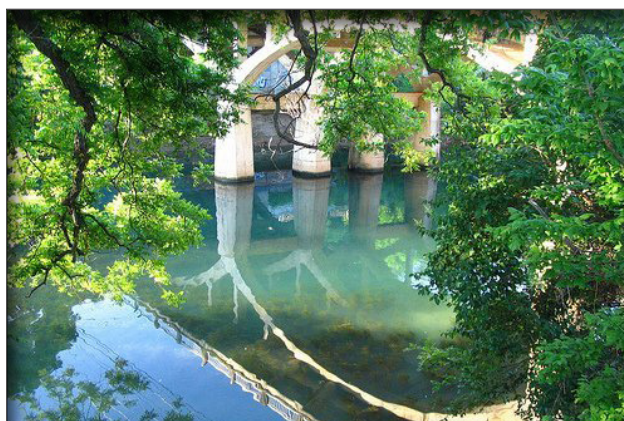

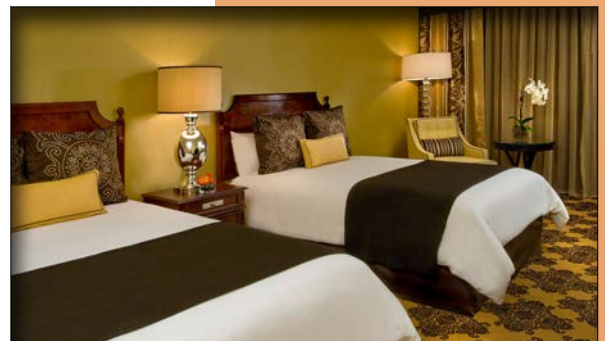
Registration
