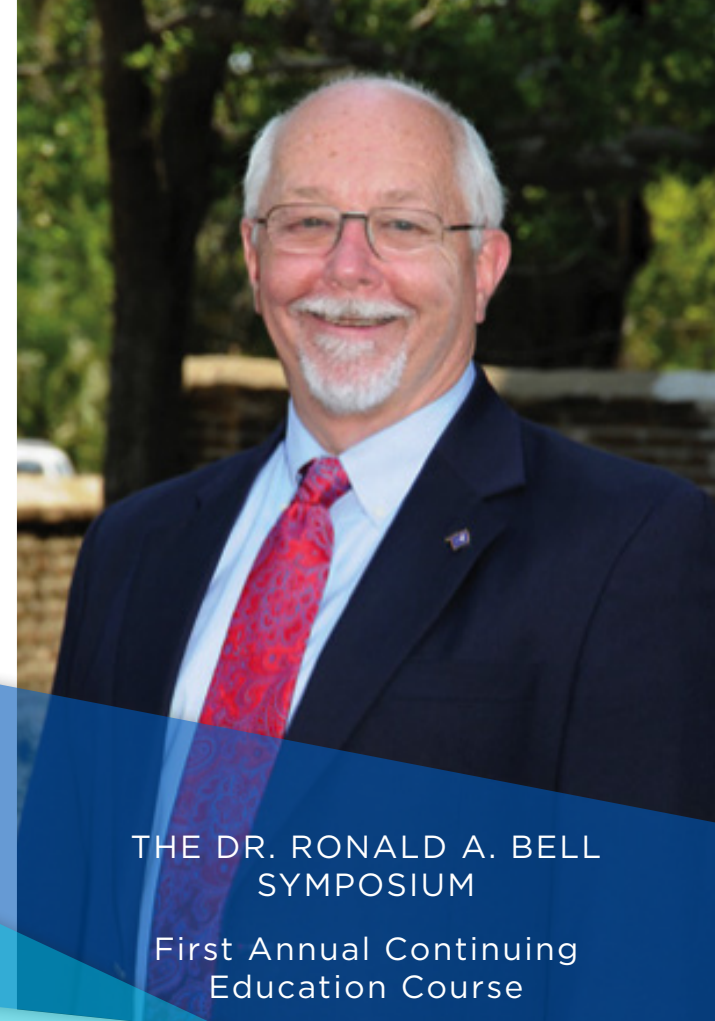
DR. RONALD A. BELL

After graduating from Louisiana State University in 1969, Dr. Bell received his D.D.S. from LSU in 1973. At the same time, he earned his Master's in Education from what was then known as LSUNO. After serving 3 years in the US Army Dental Corps, Dr. Bell returned to New Orleans to earn a Certificate in Pedodontics. In 1987 he earned a second specialty Certificate in Orthodontics at the Medical College of Georgia.

He spent his early career teaching at MCG in both Pediatric Dentistry and Orthodontics, and then accepted the position of Chairman of Pediatric Dentistry and Orthodontics at the James B. Edwards College of Dental Medicine at MUSC.

Dr. Bell stood out as an exceptional leader and educator. He was well-published in research and scientific articles, as well as textbooks. He was recognized by his peers as the elected president of The American Board of Pediatric Dentistry (2003), the College of Diplomates (2013) and the Southeastern Society of Pediatric Dentistry (2001). He was selected for "America's Top Dentists" Award 2003-2013 and "America's Top Teachers" Awards 2004-2013 and was selected Outstanding Alumnus, Louisiana State University School of Dentistry 2002. Most recently, Dr. Bell's long and distinguished career and service to South Carolina were recognized by his receiving the Order of the Palmetto, the state's highest civilian honor.

As a man, Ron meant so much to those around him. He encouraged us to be better, listen more, and enjoy life. In his passing, those who loved him would like to continue his life's work through this symposium and the Dr. Ronald A. Bell Pediatric Dentistry Memorial Scholarship, raising money to promote the education of our future colleagues in pediatric dentistry.

SPEAKERS

Dr. Martha Ann Keels received her dental degree, specialty training in Pediatric Dentistry and PhD training in Epidemiology at the University of North Carolina, Chapel Hill. Subsequently, she established the Pediatric Dental program at Duke and serves as the Division Chief of Pediatric Dentistry at Duke Children's Hospital. She is board certified in pediatric dentistry and has served on the ABPD Examination Committee for OCE since 2008. Dr. Keels holds Fellowships in the American Academy of Pediatric Dentistry, American College of Dentists, the International College of Dentists. She received NIH funding for an epidemiological study of fluoridation and is currently funded by the NIH assessing caries risk factor analysis.

Dr. Gerry Samson completed pediatric dental residency at Emory University in 1979 and orthodontics at Northwestern University in 1981. Since that time Gerry has been in private orthodontic practice, is a Diplomat of The American Board of Orthodontics and a Fellow of The American College of Dentists. Dr. Samson holds formal faculty appointments at 7 postgraduate programs, lectures extensively and reviews orthodontic mechanics articles submitted for publication to The Angle Orthodontist. Described as an educational entertainer, Gerry offers meaty clinical presentations spiced with a blend of biting wit, edgy humor, and substantially sauced with evidenced based literature. Gerry's zany, brainy and engaging methods have made him one of today's most popular educators. His favorite Dr. Bell quote is "Keep on truckin".

Dr. Andy Sonis is a graduate of Tufts University School of Dental Medicine. He received his pediatric dental training at Boston Children's Hospital and Harvard University School of Dental Medicine, his orthodontic training at Boston University Goldman School of Dentistry, and his oral medicine training at Louisiana State University School of Dentistry. He has been board certified in oral medicine, pediatric dentistry, and orthodontics, and is on the editorial board of Pediatric Dentistry. He currently holds the rank of Clinical Professor in the Department of Developmental Biology at Harvard and is Senior Associate in the Department of Dentistry at Children's Hospital, Boston. He is a partner in a group dental practice in Newton, Massachusetts.

Dr. Scott Goodman began his dental education at The Ohio State University. After graduating, Goodman continued his studies at Memorial Hospital's GPR program in Worcester, Massachusetts followed by his fellowship at the Bowman Gray School of Medicine prior to earning his pediatric dental certificate from the University of Iowa. He is an Adjunct Associate Professor at the University Of Texas Health Science Center Department of Pediatric Dentistry and an Adjunct Assistant Professor at the University of North Carolina Department of Pediatric Dentistry. He is also a Diplomate of the American Board of Pediatric Dentistry, and Fellow of both the American Academy of Pediatric Dentistry and International College of Dentists. Dr. Goodman is currently working in a thriving private practice in the Charlotte area.

Dr. Jed Best is a Diplomate of the American Board of Pediatric Dentistry. Currently, Dr. Best holds Associate Clinical Professor positions at both Columbia University College of Dental Medicine and Case Western Reserve University School of Dental Medicine. He has also, proudly served as the past President of the College of Diplomates of the American Board of Pediatric Dentistry.

Dr. Brandon Schwindt is a graduate of Oregon Health and Sciences University Dental School. He completed his pediatric dental residency at MUSC in 2003 under Dr. Ronald Bell and was awarded the American Board of Pediatric Dentistry's Richard Pugh Award. He currently serves on the board of the Western Society of Pediatric Dentistry, is a member of the College of Diplomates and is past president of the Oregon Academy of Pediatric Dentistry. Dr. Schwindt has been appointed to Oregon's board of Dentistry and currently serves as President. He maintains a private practice in Portland, Oregon.
