FEATURED SPEAKER



Dr. Andrew Herlich is Professor and Vice Chair for Faculty Development in the Department of Anesthesiology at the University of Pittsburgh School of Medicine. He is a staff anesthesiologist and serves as the site Academic Director at UPMC Mercy. Dr. Herlich was the designer and first Medical Director of the Temple University School of Medicine Human Simulation and Patient Safety Center and serves as a faculty facilitator at the Peter M. Winter Institute for Simulation Education and Research (WISER).

Dr. Herlich, who graduated from Tufts University School of Dental Medicine, is a recognized leader in his field. He is widely published, with over 70 articles, and a recipient of three prestigious NIH grants including a 3-year trainee grant, a 5-year RO-1 grant for facial pain and an orphan disease grant. He has received many honors in recognition of his outstanding clinical care, teaching and research. He was named Professor of the Year in 2000 at Temple University, and has been named as one of America's Top Doctors by Castle Connolly every year since 2006. He is listed in Marquis' Who's Who in the United States, and was selected as one of Pittsburgh Magazine's Best Doctors in 2012 and 2013. Dr. Herlich was invited as the Daniel Waite Lecturer at the University of Minnesota in 2007, and received the Horace Wells Award of Merit in 2008. In 2009, he was awarded the Malignant Hyperthermia Association Award for Outstanding Dedication to the association, and has earned several Outstanding Educator honors in the Department of Anesthesiology at the University of Pittsburgh School of Medicine.

An active member of many prestigious societies, Dr. Herlich serves on the Board of Directors and is President-Elect of the Pennsylvania Society of Anesthesiologists. He is a Delegate to the American Society of Anesthesiologists, an Honorary Fellow of AAOMS, and has served as a long-standing liaison between ASA and AAOMS, ADSA and ADA.
