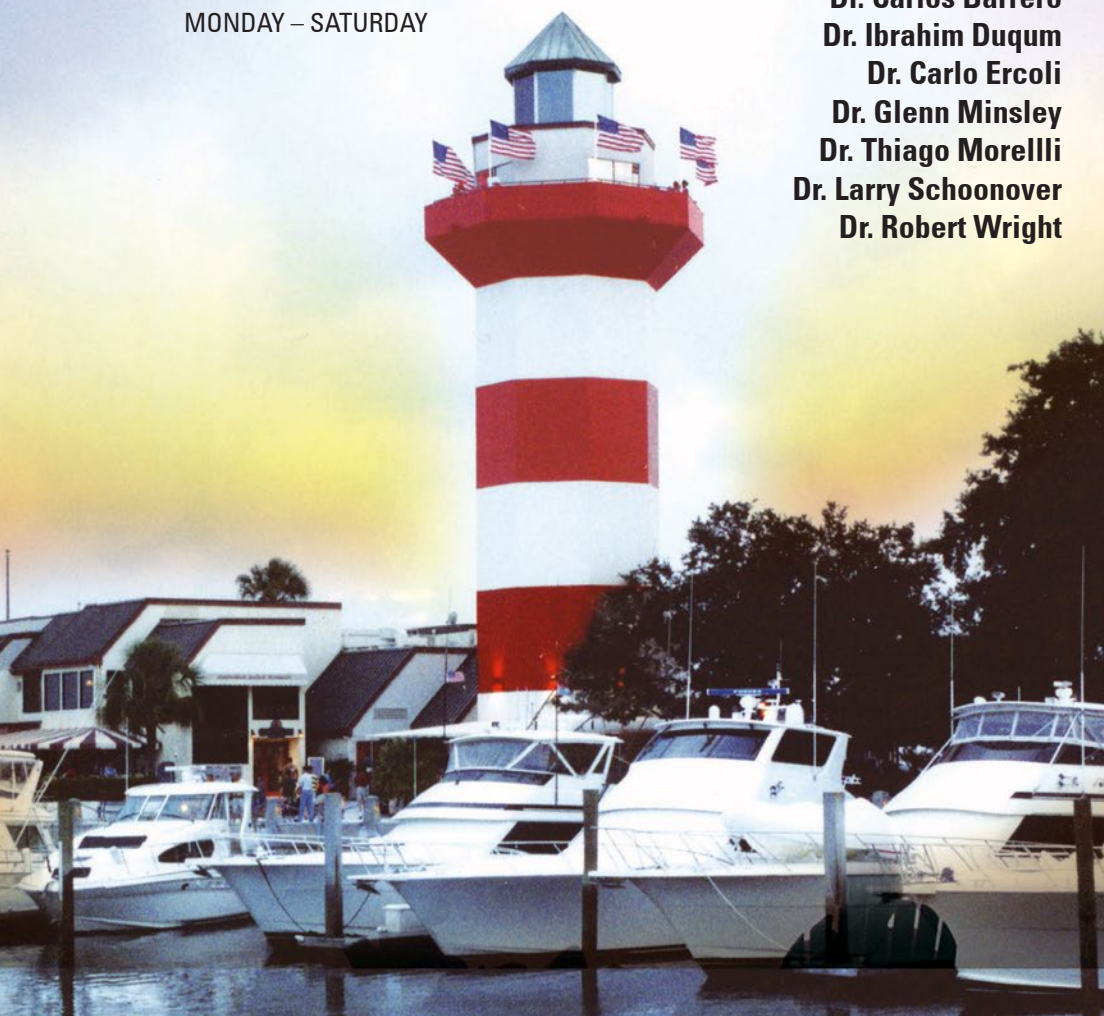

ABOUT THE SPEAKERS

Dr. Carlo Ercoli graduated from the “Enrico Berlinguer” Dental Technology Institute in Rome in 1987 and obtained his dental degree from the University of Siena, Italy in 1993. He specialized in Prosthodontics in 1996 at the Eastman Dental Center in Rochester, New York, where he also completed a one-year training in Temporomandibular Joint Disorders in 1997. In 2012, he achieved specialty certification in Periodontology at the University of Rochester Eastman Institute for Oral Health. He is currently Professor, Chairman and Program Director of the Prosthodontic Specialty Training Program at the University of Rochester, Eastman Institute for Oral Health and a faculty member of the Periodontology Program.

Dr. Ercoli is a diplomate of the American Boards of Prosthodontics and Periodontology, an ITI Fellow and holds memberships in several dental organizations including the American and International Association of Dental Research, American Academy of Periodontology, the American College of Prosthodontists, Academy of Osseointegration, American Academy of Fixed Prosthodontics and American Prosthodontic Society. He is a Past President of the American Prosthodontic Society.

Dr. Ercoli has authored several publications and his research interests are focused on the biomechanics of dental implants, cutting protocols for bone and tooth preparation, and on clinical and laboratory testing of dental materials and techniques. He maintains a faculty practice limited to Prosthodontics and Periodontics. He has lectured nationally and internationally on several topics related to clinical prosthodontics and implant dentistry.

Dr. Larry Schoonover graduated from WVU, established a general practice in Clendenin, WV, and attended the L.D. Pankey Institute in 1980, adding a second practice in Elkins in 1995. He is a Master of the AGD. Dr. Schoonover began the transition to Mini Dental Implants in 2005 and became an Opinion Leader for IMTEC, and later for 3M-ESPE. As Assistant Clinical Professor at WVU, he integrated MDI's into the pre-doctoral curriculum. Dr. Schoonover has spoken for the National Rural Health Care Association; the Michigan, Florida, and Kentucky Dental Associations; the Ohio AGD; the ADA; Albert Schweitzer Hospital; Evolution Dental Science; Midwest Dental; and 3M-ESPE. He has trained hundreds of dentists in MDI placement in removable, fixed, and immediate extraction site applications as well as bone grafting for site development.

Dr. Carlos Barrero received his dental degree from the University El Bosque in Bogota Colombia. Soon after graduation, he continued his studies at the University of Rutgers where he completed his postgraduate training in Prosthodontics (1998) and Masters Degree in Oral Biology (1999). Dr. Barrero moved to Chapel Hill in 1999 to complete a Fellowship in teaching Prosthodontics at UNC-CH School of Dentistry. In 2002 he went to the University of Minnesota where he held an Assistant Professor position with the University of Minnesota-School of Dentistry for eight years before returning to UNC as a Clinical Associate Professor of Prosthodontics in 2008 where he currently is a senior group practice director and balances the demands of an academic career.

Dr. Glenn Minsley has been a full-time faculty of the Department of Prosthodontics for 33 years. During that entire period, he has directed the maxillofacial prosthetics portion of the Graduate Prosthodontic program at the UNC SOD as well as being the Chief of the Division of Maxillofacial Prosthetics for the Department of Hospital Dentistry at UNC Hospitals. He also was the Director of the pre-clinical course on Complete Dentures for 26 years. His research interests included studies on respiratory airway effects from maxillary resection and prosthetic obturation, as well as osseointegration of implants in irradiated bone.

Dr. Thiago Morelli is a Clinical Assistant Professor in the Department of Periodontology, School of Dentistry at the University of North Carolina at Chapel Hill. Dr. Morelli received his DDS degree from the University of Sao Paulo, Brazil. He later received a DDS degree from the University of Detroit Mercy, and a Certificate and Master's degree in Periodontology from the University of Michigan. Dr. Morelli is a Diplomate of the American Board of Periodontology and a Fellow of the International Team for Implantology (ITI). Dr. Morelli serves as the Director of the Predoctoral Periodontal Program and the Dental Implant course director for the Postdoctoral Graduate program at UNC. He has published and lectured in the fields of Regenerative Medicine, Salivary Diagnostics, and Tissue Engineering as it relates to periodontal and peri-implant reconstruction. Dr. Thiago Morelli has extensive clinical experience in treatment of periodontal diseases, soft tissue and bone graft procedures, and dental implants. He actively participates in the UNC Dental Faculty Practice.
