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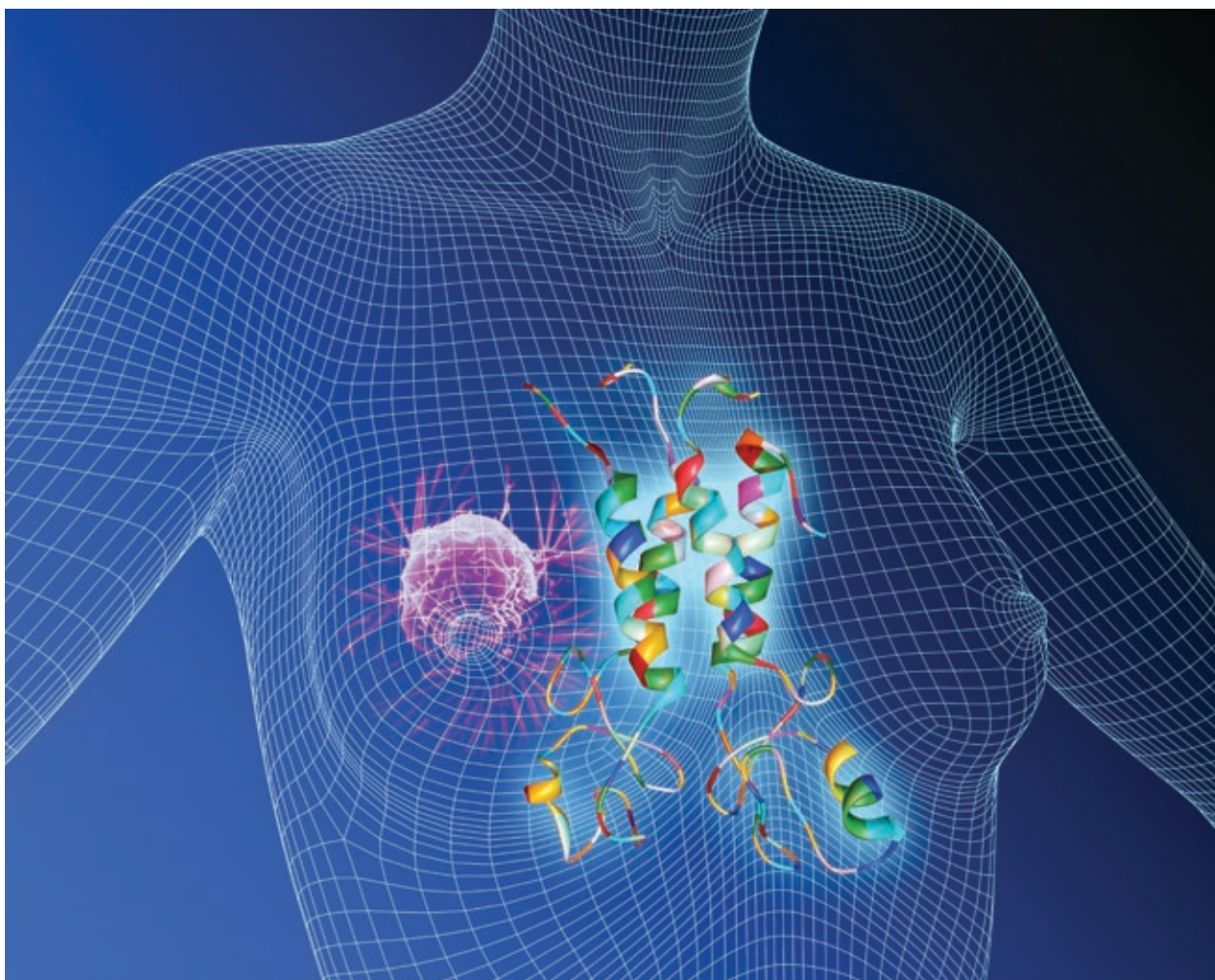

I am pleased to announce that we are holding the 8th Annual Royal Marsden Breast Cancer Meeting on Friday 2nd October 2015. As in previous years the aim of our meeting is to provide an update on what is new, clinically relevant and controversial in the management of patients with breast cancer. This year our programme will include challenging issues in Metastatic Breast Cancer, we shall be looking in depth at the management of Invasive Lobular Cancer, and we'll be reviewing the role of Acupuncture in the treatment of menopausal and other survivorship symptoms.
