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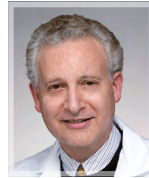

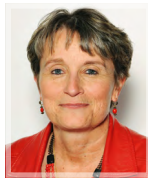

How do we extend lessons from TAVI experience to the Mitral Valve ?

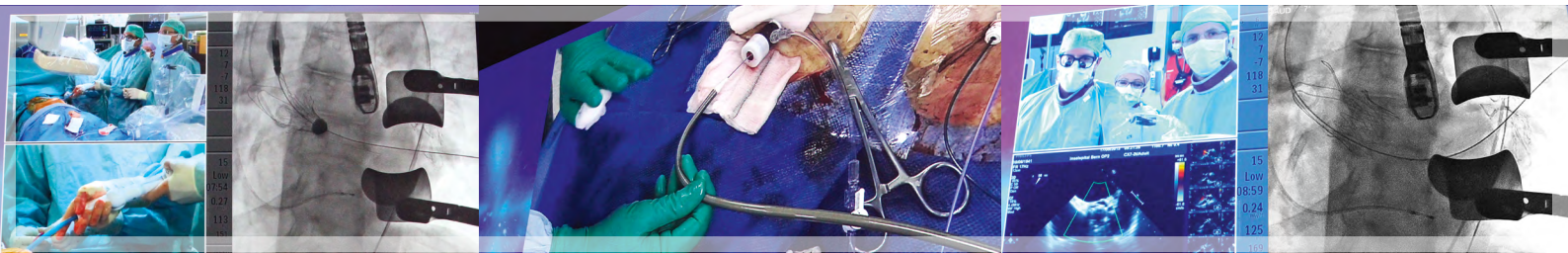
A panel of experts in different areas in valvular heart disease will debate around this topic.
