With a keynote address from **Ann Slee**, ePrescribing Lead at NHS England, this conference looks at moving forward with Electronic Prescribing and Medicines Administration (EPMA) in a hospital setting. The final session will discuss maintenance of existing prescribing systems and developing new functionality including transitioning between systems.
