

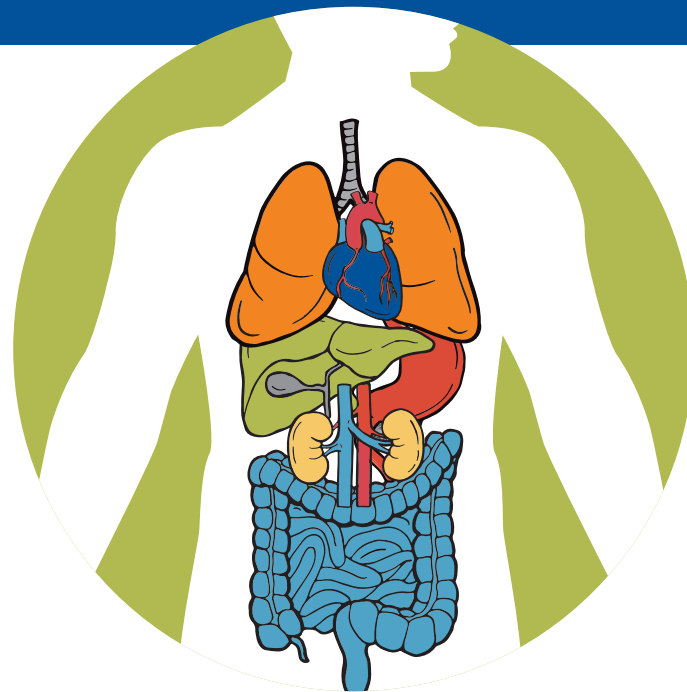

The Duke Transplant Advanced Practice Provider Bootcamp is an intensive course that incorporates didactic and hands-on education for nurse practitioners and physician assistants in the field of solid organ transplantation. This educational program is designed to facilitate the APP's role in perioperative management and improve competency in pertinent procedures. The educational goals of this course are to enhance knowledge of the following topics:

- Multiple organ transplantation
- Immunology
- Immunosuppression

- Hepatitis C + donor organs
- Liver OrganOx normothermic perfusion pump
- Abdominal wall transplants
- Hand transplants
- HOPE act organs
