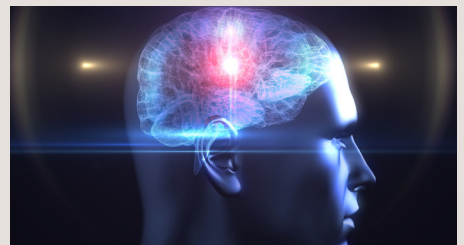

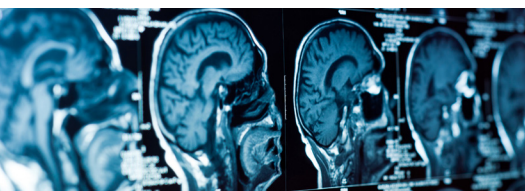
ATTENDANCE POLICIES
