

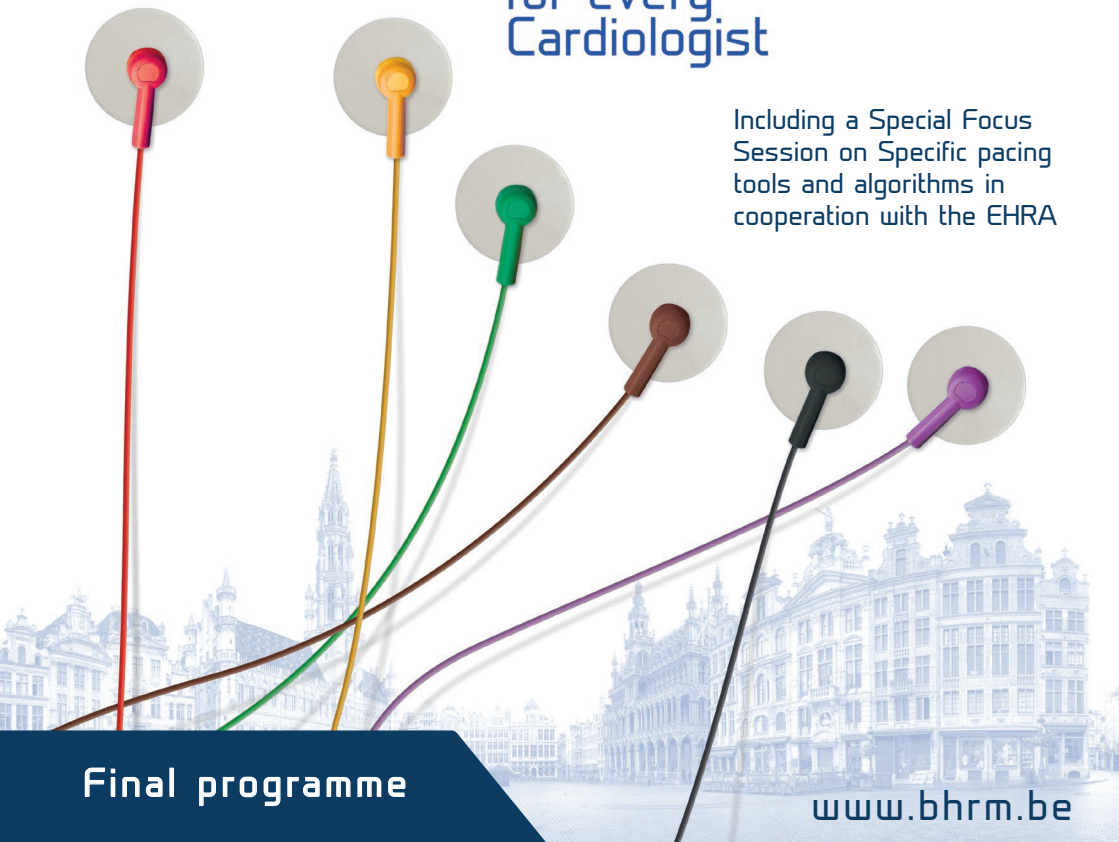

We look forward to meeting you next October, so mark your calendar and don't miss this opportunity!

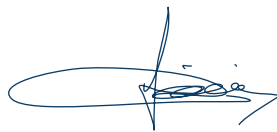

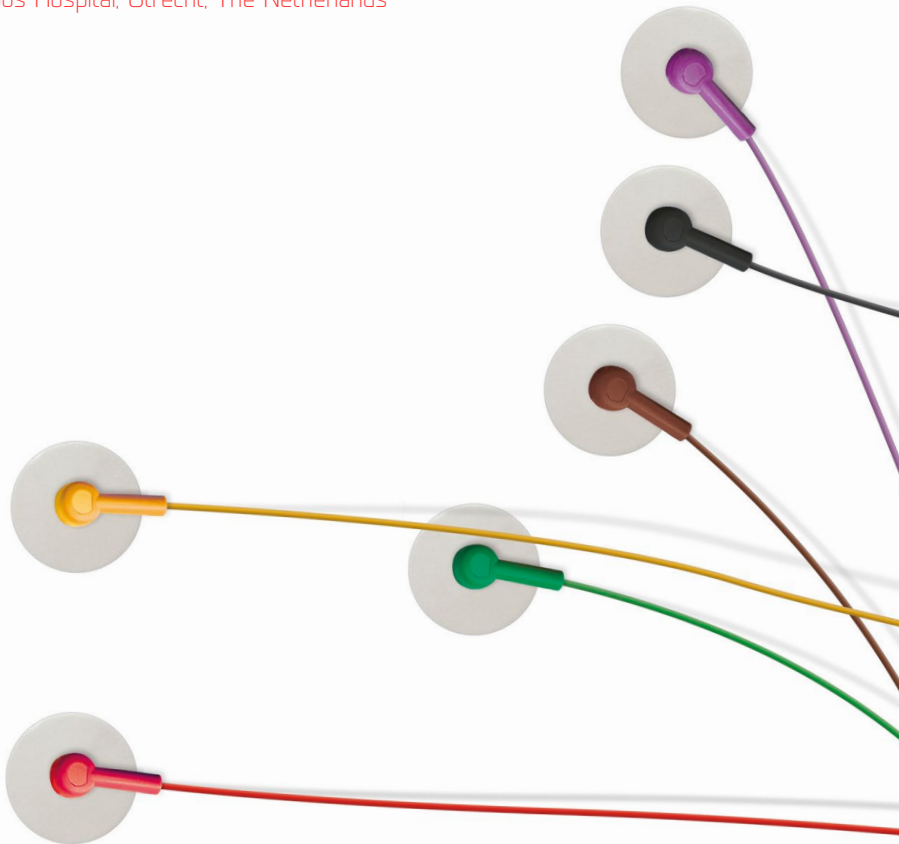
