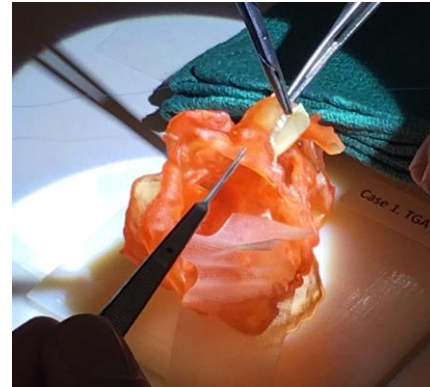

Course Description:

Children's Health Dallas and the University of Texas Southwestern are pleased to present a 2 ½-day, hands-on congenital heart disease surgery course. Attendees will have the opportunity to perform five surgical procedures on their own 3D printed models, and new for this year, view them on 3D displays. The cases include: tetralogy of Fallot; complete transposition of the great arteries with intact ventricular septum; two different forms of double outlet right ventricle; and hypoplastic left heart syndrome. The hands-on sessions for each case will be preceded by didactic lectures on surgical anatomy, as well as discussions on the techniques. Attendees will be divided into groups of two and each will have the opportunity to perform the procedures as primary operator and assistant. Established cardiovascular surgeons will be available for advice and demonstration of the procedures throughout the course.

Accreditation:
