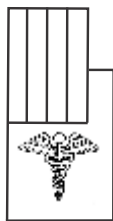

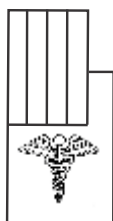

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Places to visit in Jaipur



Amber Fort and Palace: A majestic fort with a hilltop setting and an opulent palace within its premises that's Amber Fort and Palace for you. One of the most iconic forts in Jaipur, Amber Fort is steeped in history and remains a glorious example of architectural brilliance. The fort includes magnificent structures like the Sheesh Mahal, Shukh Niwas, and the Diwan-e-Khas or Hall of Private Audience. The light and sound show held here every evening brings alive the fort and its history, which is something you must not miss out on.

Nahargarh Fort: The rocky ridges of the Aravali Hills cradle Nahargarh Fort, a majestic monument that overlooks Jaipur and offers a stunning view of the city's landscape. Built in 1734 by Jai Singh II, the then Maharaja of Jaipur, Nahargarh Fort was part of the city's defense circle, along with Amer Fort and Jaigarh Fort. The fort served as a hunting retreat for the royal family. Today it is a splendid viewpoint to watch glorious sunsets over the Pink City.



Hawa Mahal: Hawa Mahal is a five-storied pyramidal edifice constructed out of red and pink sandstone and is among the most popular tourist places to visit in Jaipur. Built by Maharaja Sawai Pratap Singh in 1799, it features 953 small windows and looks like a honeycombed hive. The interior chambers of this building enjoy a cooling effect due to the breeze blowing in through its incredible lattice of windows. If you climb to the top of the Hawa Mahal, you can get amazing views of the City Palace and the Jantar Mantar from there.

Jal Mahal: Standing in the middle of the Man Sagar Lake, Jal Mahal is a spectacular five-storied palace that features the Rajput style of architecture. It was built as a hunting lodge for the rulers of this land. When the lake is full, four of these stories remain submerged under the water and only the top one remains visible. The palace is off-limits for visitors, but you can always enjoy its picturesque view by taking a boat ride in the lake.



Birla Mandir: Also known as Laxmi Narayan Temple, the Birla Temple is one of the most magnificent temples in Jaipur. Built with resplendent white marble stones, the temple stands against the backdrop of lush greenery and presents a breath-taking sight. The walls of the temple are ornamented with various scenes and quotes from the Bhagavad Gita. This grand place of worship looks spellbinding when illuminated at night.

Govind Dev Ji Temple: Housed within the City Palace complex, Govind Ji Temple is another religious place to visit in the city. As the name suggests, the presiding deity here is Lord Krishna. It was Raja Sawai Jai Singh II, an ardent Krishna devotee, who brought the idol of this temple from Vrindavan. It is said that the idol was made by Bajranabh, the great-grandson of Lord Krishna. Visit the temple to experience the serenity of the place.



World Trade Park: The World Trade Park Mall is a shopper's paradise. Though it is a relatively new shopping destination in the city, it has quickly become one of the favorite shopping malls in Jaipur. With well-known brands like Calvin Klein, Marks n Spencer, Celio, Zara, and others selling their merchandise here, you can have an amazing shopping experience at this mall. Also, there are a number of top-class restaurants to take care of your hunger when you are tired from all that shopping.

Akshardham Temple: Akshardham Temple is a beautiful religious place for Hindus dedicated to Lord Vishnu and is a popular tourist attraction in Jaipur. Devotees from across India, visit this stunning temple to pay respects and revel in the sacred ambience.



Places to visit near by Jaipur



Alwar: 138 Kms From Jaipur: For those who love Mughal architecture, ancient forts, and ruins, there's nothing that beats Alwar and Alwar happens to be one of the best places near Jaipur to visit. Undoubtedly, Alwar is one of best places to visit near Jaipur for a fulfilling weekend. Whether it is a mysterious fort that tells you stories of the gone time, vintage forts, or sparkling lake for boating and relaxing—Alwar is a complete package offering intense travel delight. If you are planning a trip to Jaipur in February, do not miss to visit Alwar for Alwar Festival. In November and December, you can experience the lively Matsya Festival.

Ajmer: 153 Kms From Jaipur: Among all the gorgeous places near Jaipur to visit during weekends, Ajmer stands out. Ajmer reflects divinity and a special kind of charm. Attractions like the marvelous Dargah Sharif of Moinuddin Chishti, Ana Sagar Lake, and Taragarh Fort will make your trip worthwhile. People visit this holy city particularly during weekends for the ultimate peace and joy. It is one of the best places near Jaipur to visit.



Pushkar: 161 Kms From Jaipur: Pushkar is a relaxing weekend destination with so many photogenic attractions. In the league of refreshing places to visit around Jaipur, Pushkar is a prominent name. People from Jaipur and Delhi visit this city to take a dip in the holy lake of Pushkar. One can visit the temples, enjoy Pushkar camel fair during summer, and go on easy hikes. The town has a bustling market to explore and buy colorful local knickknacks and souvenirs.

Chittorgarh: 305 Kms From Jaipur: Known for a palatial, 700-acred fort built on the top of a mountain, Chittorgarh is a place well known for rich heritage and far-sung history. The place has been the battleground of many wars, especially the one Alauddin Khilji fought in order to seize the control of the city. With forts, ruins and old citadels still standing the test of time, and so many exciting things to do in Chittorgarh, this is one of the best places to visit near Jaipur Rajasthan.



Ranthambore National Park: 122 Kms From Jaipur: Ranthambore is known as heaven for the wildlife enthusiasts and this place is widely recognized for the tiger reserve and the national park. Apart from this, the palaces, mesmerizing locales make Ranthambore special as a tourist attraction. Tourists can opt for a safari ride that is considered as the most adventurous activity among all others. This also gives you the chance to experience the wild species that are freely roaming around in the jungle. There are almost 330 species of birds in the bird sanctuary.

Vrindavan: 232 Kms From Jaipur: Vrindavan is one of the oldest cities and is located on the banks of Yamuna river. It is considered as one of the most sacred places around Jaipur and is also an important pilgrimage destination for Krishna's devotees. It is believed that Lord Krishna spent his childhood in this city. It is one of the most sacred places and people come here to get rid of their worldly life. The city is full of temples of Lord Krishna and temples of Radha.
