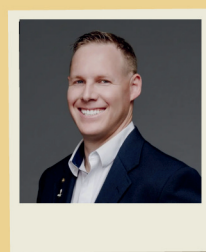

Endodontics-The Art of Maintaining the Natural Tooth

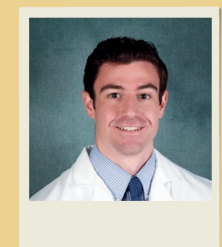

Specialists Spotlight

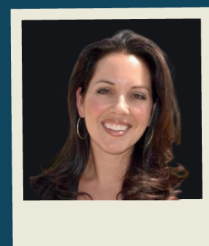
