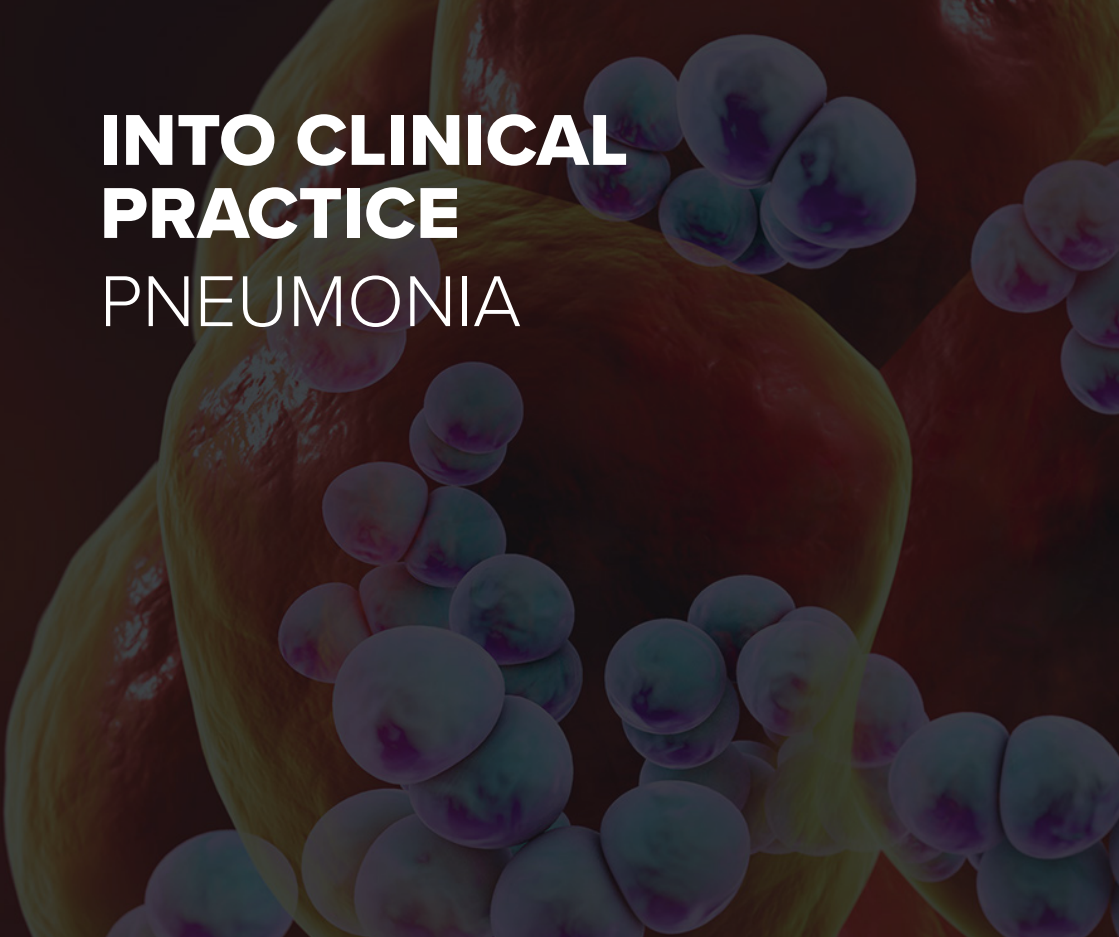
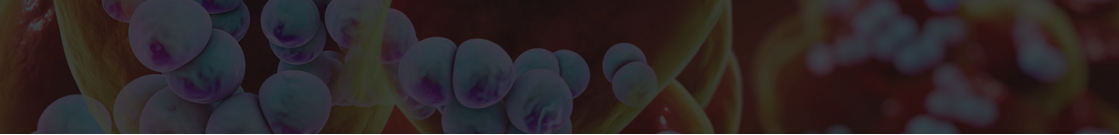

This exciting one day conference which will explore the current challenges and treatment opportunities for Pneumonia.

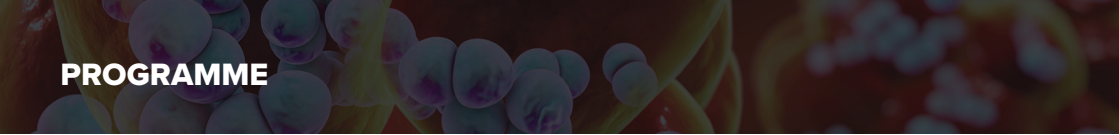
