Skills training is a workshop which will provide delegates with skills needed to improve needle imaging. Needle imaging looks at strategies which can be used to image the needle tip with precision, insert a catheter and check catheter position. Phantoms will allow injections to be made and injection techniques to be developed.

All around the block will help improve decision-making in the management of common regional anaesthesia scenarios. It is suitable for both novice and expert, with particular value for those with limited formal US skills training. It will also be useful for those involved in regional anaesthesia teaching and education.
