- Dr. James McCarthy, the director of the Division of Pediatric Orthopaedic Surgery at Cincinnati Children's Hospital, will be the visiting professor.

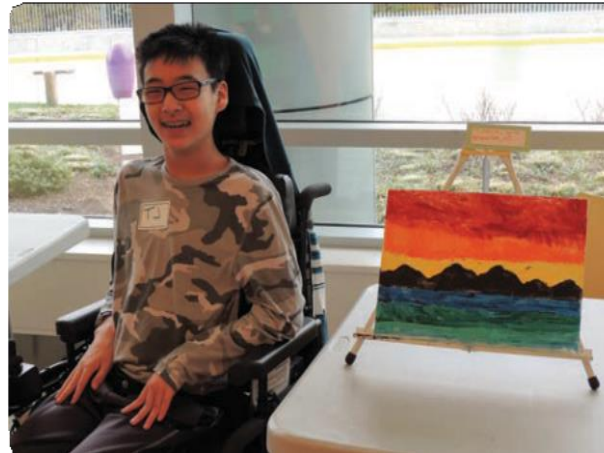
